## A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the President and Congress of the United States to take
- immediate action to preserve the underwater graves of
- 3 servicepersons who died defending this nation.
- 4 WHEREAS, The underwater graves of dead servicepersons from
- 5 various nations are being disturbed, destroyed and removed by
- 6 illegal salvaging operations; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The looting of sunken warships from the United
- 8 States, the United Kingdom, the Netherlands, Australia and Japan
- 9 in the waters of southeast Asia is ongoing; and
- 10 WHEREAS, These sunken warships are being blown up and cut
- 11 apart for scrap metal by large ships with giant cranes and grab
- 12 dredgers without regard for the human remains of the dead
- 13 servicepersons who occupied the warships; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Naval shipwrecks are the property of nations and
- 15 protected under international law; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Our nation has a solemn obligation to protect the
- 17 final resting place of the servicepersons who died defending

- 1 this nation; therefore be it
- 2 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
- 3 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the President and
- 4 Congress of the United States to take immediate action to
- 5 preserve the underwater graves of servicepersons who died
- 6 defending this nation; and be it further
- 7 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 8 the President of the United States and each member of Congress
- 9 from Pennsylvania.
