A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commemorating the 100th anniversary of The American Legion, and recognizing and honoring the legacy of The American Legion as
- a staunch advocate for veterans and their families.
- 4 WHEREAS, The American Legion came to life in Paris, France,
- 5 beginning on March 15, 1919, when war-weary members of the
- 6 American Expeditionary Forces who had fought in World War I
- 7 gathered for what became known as the Paris Caucus; and
- 8 WHEREAS, As the members continued to meet and the months
- 9 progressed, they thought about how to support their wounded
- 10 comrades, honor the fallen, assist surviving spouses and
- 11 orphans, protect the democracy they pledged their lives to
- 12 defend and chart a new course for future generations of
- 13 Americans; and
- 14 WHEREAS, They saw their vision become a reality when on

- 1 September 16, 1919, the American Legion was chartered by
- 2 Congress as a patriotic veterans organization focusing on
- 3 service to veterans, service members and communities; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The American Legion was founded on the four pillars
- 5 of: care for veterans, a strong national defense, Americanism
- 6 and children and youth; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The American Legion has played a leading role in
- 8 initiatives and breakthroughs that have affected the lives of
- 9 Americans in every community from creating the United States
- 10 Flag Code, helping start the Veterans Administration, drafting
- 11 and getting passed the GI Bill and helping veterans receive
- 12 benefits for health-care conditions based on their honorable
- 13 service; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The American Legion has nearly 3,000 accredited
- 15 service officers worldwide, who assist veterans with their
- 16 benefits claims and other concerns; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The national membership stands at over 2 million
- 18 with over 200,000 Legionnaires from Pennsylvania; therefore be
- 19 it
- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate the
- 21 100th anniversary of The American Legion, and recognize and
- 22 honor the historical significance and valorous service and
- 23 sacrifice of the United States Armed Forces; and be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the legacy
- 25 of The American Legion as a staunch advocate for veterans and
- 26 their families; and be it further
- 27 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commend The
- 28 American Legion for their service to veterans for the past 100
- 29 years as well as their continuous service as they begin their
- 30 second century; and be it further

- 2 resident of this Commonwealth to join in the commemoration of
- 3 the centennial of The American Legion on March 15, 2019.
