## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the week of May 5 through 12, 2019, as "National Music Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Music is the universal language of the world,
- 4 inspiring millions of people around the globe in a multitude of
- 5 positive ways; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Sponsored annually by the National Federation of
- 7 Music Clubs (NFMC), "National Music Week" serves to enhance our
- 8 understanding and appreciation of the value of music in the
- 9 home, the community, the nation and the world; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The week of May 5 through 12, 2019, will signal the
- 11 94th annual observance of "National Music Week"; and
- 12 WHEREAS, This year's theme is "Music...A Magic Key"; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Music can bring joy to each person's life,
- 14 refreshing and soothing our minds and giving lofty inspiration
- 15 to our souls; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Listening to music is one of the most popular forms
- 17 of entertainment and is enjoyed by individuals and groups from
- 18 virtually all walks of life; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Music is an integral part of the American cultural
- 2 experience and is ubiquitous in our everyday lives; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Music stimulates the imagination, is often thought
- 4 provoking, can generate a wide range of emotions and may evoke
- 5 fond memories; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The study of music enhances learning, and composing
- 7 and performing music provides a rich, rewarding experience for
- 8 people of all ages; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Music distinguishes generations of people from one
- 10 another and, at the same time, can uniquely establish a common
- 11 bond between different generations; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Music is an important form of art that can reflect
- 13 the history and culture of a region, state or country; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Music is a key element of most artistic
- 15 performances, including dance, theater and film; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Music can be spiritual in nature, and virtually all
- 17 religions utilize music in their expression of spiritual life;
- 18 and
- 19 WHEREAS, Music has vast potential to inspire peace, harmony
- 20 and understanding among disparate peoples, and to penetrate and
- 21 tear down walls of intolerance, hatred and injustice around the
- 22 world; and
- 23 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has a rich history and tradition
- 24 of musical involvement and enjoyment in the lives of its
- 25 residents; therefore be it
- 26 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 27 week of May 5 through 12, 2019, as "National Music Week" in
- 28 Pennsylvania; and be it further
