A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of August 2019 as "Stevens-Johnson Syndrome Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Stevens-Johnson syndrome (SJS) and toxic epidermal
- 4 necrolysis syndrome, another form of SJS, are severe allergic
- 5 reactions to prescription and over-the-counter medications; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Individuals afflicted with SJS experience severe
- 7 inflammation of the mucus membranes and, if left untreated, SJS
- 8 can result in blindness, other serious health problems and
- 9 death; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Since its inception, the Stevens Johnson Syndrome
- 11 Foundation has remained true to its mission and goal of
- 12 providing support, education and advocacy through the
- 13 compilation and distribution of valuable information about SJS
- 14 to the public and medical professionals regarding treatments and
- 15 therapies; therefore be it
