A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of October 2019 as "Domestic Violence Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Domestic violence is a pattern of abusive behavior
- 4 used to establish power and control over an intimate partner;
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, Domestic violence often causes emotional harm to
- 7 victims, their children, other family members, friends,
- 8 neighbors and coworkers; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Domestic violence affects individuals from all
- 10 racial, ethnic, religious, educational, social and economic
- 11 backgrounds and takes many forms; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Assault, harassment, threats, vandalism,
- 13 trespassing, burglary, theft and stalking may occur; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Abusive behaviors often escalate, causing physical

- 1 and emotional trauma, anxiety, stress, sleep deprivation, loss
- 2 of confidence, fear and, in some cases, injury and death by
- 3 suicide or homicide; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Domestic violence is one of the most chronically
- 5 underreported crimes; and
- 6 WHEREAS, There are many barriers to detecting domestic
- 7 violence; and
- 8 WHEREAS, An estimated 1 in 4 women and 1 in 9 men will
- 9 experience domestic violence during their lifetime; and
- 10 WHEREAS, An attempted or completed rape is experienced by 1
- 11 in 6 women and 1 in 33 men; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Approximately 1.3 million women and 835,000 men are
- 13 physically assaulted by an intimate partner annually in the
- 14 United States; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Perpetrators of intimate partner violence also abuse
- 16 children in the home 30% to 60% of the time; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Intimate partner violence results in more than 18.5
- 18 million mental health care visits each year; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The cost of intimate partner violence exceeds \$5.8
- 20 billion each year, \$4.1 billion of which is for direct medical
- 21 and mental health services; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Less than 35% of victims who report an injury from
- 23 intimate partner violence seek medical treatment following the
- 24 injury; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Children who witness domestic violence in their
- 26 homes are 74% more likely to commit criminal assaults as adults;
- 27 and
- 28 WHEREAS, Collectively, victims of domestic violence lose
- 29 almost 8 million days of paid work annually; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Businesses forfeit approximately \$100 million in

- 1 lost wages, sick leave, absenteeism and nonproductivity
- 2 annually; and
- 3 WHEREAS, An estimated 20% of those who experience intimate
- 4 partner violence obtain protection from abuse orders; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Each year, domestic violence programs in this
- 6 Commonwealth provide services to approximately 95,000 victims of
- 7 domestic violence; and
- 8 WHEREAS, To increase victim safety, authorities must
- 9 carefully follow screening, reporting, documentation and
- 10 referral requirements; and
- 11 WHEREAS, At-risk individuals and families need education
- 12 relating to their legal rights, judicial proceedings, advocacy,
- 13 counseling and support services, shelter care and crisis
- 14 intervention; therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 16 month of October 2019 as "Domestic Violence Awareness Month" in
- 17 Pennsylvania.
