## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of January 2020 as "School Director Recognition Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Local school districts and their governing boards
- 4 were established by the General Assembly more than 150 years
- 5 ago; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Public education is mandated by section 14 of
- 7 Article III of the Constitution of Pennsylvania; and
- 8 WHEREAS, School board members govern individual school
- 9 districts, establish local policies, approve educational
- 10 programs, provide necessary physical facilities, hire properly
- 11 certified professional and classified employees and share in
- 12 costs by raising necessary local funds, along with State funds,
- 13 to operate district educational programs; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Being an effective school director is a difficult
- 15 task, particularly in the current climate of school change; and
- 16 WHEREAS, A school director must be knowledgeable about many

- 1 complex educational and social issues; and
- 2 WHEREAS, School board service is a pure form of grassroots
- 3 democratic involvement upon which our republic was founded; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Local public school directors are dedicated,
- 5 educated and responsible citizens who carry out voluntary public
- 6 service, a classic example of representative government in our
- 7 democracy; therefore be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 9 month of January 2020 as "School Director Recognition Month" in
- 10 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 11 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 12 the Pennsylvania School Boards Association.
