A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of September 7 through 11, 2020, as "National Payroll Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The American Payroll Association and more than
- 4 20,000 of its members are launching a nationwide public
- 5 awareness campaign that pays tribute to the nearly 150 million
- 6 people who work in the United States and the payroll
- 7 professionals who support the system by paying wages, reporting
- 8 worker earnings and withholding Federal employment taxes; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Payroll professionals in Pennsylvania play a key
- 10 role in maintaining the economic health of our Commonwealth,
- 11 carrying out diverse tasks that include paying into the
- 12 unemployment insurance system, providing information for child
- 13 support enforcement and carrying out tax withholding, reporting
- 14 and depositing; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Collectively, payroll departments spend more than
- 16 \$2.4 trillion annually to comply with the myriad of Federal and
- 17 state wage and tax laws; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Payroll professionals play an increasingly important
- 2 role in ensuring the economic security of American families by
- 3 helping to identify noncustodial parents and making sure that
- 4 they comply with their child support mandates; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Payroll professionals have become increasingly
- 6 proactive in educating the business community and the public at
- 7 large about the payroll tax withholding systems; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Payroll professionals meet regularly with Federal
- 9 and state tax officials to discuss improving compliance with
- 10 governmental procedures and how compliance can be achieved at
- 11 less cost to government and businesses; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The week of September 7 through 11, 2020, has been
- 13 proclaimed "National Payroll Week"; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 15 week of September 7 through 11, 2020, as "National Payroll Week"
- 16 in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commend the
- 18 American Payroll Association for its campaign to recognize wage
- 19 earners and payroll professionals.
