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## A RESOLUTION

- Adopting temporary Rules of the House of Representatives
- relating to roll call votes, to voting meetings of 2
- committees, to consideration of bills, to third consideration and final passage bills, to conference committee reports and 3
- 4
- to members' and employees' expenses; and repealing the 5
- temporary Rule adopted March 16, 2020.
- 7 RESOLVED, That this resolution adopts temporary rules to
- apply notwithstanding provisions in the Rules of the House of
- Representatives; and be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That a member who is not present in the Hall of the
- 11 House may designate either the Majority or Minority Whip to cast
- 12 the member's vote on any question as to which there has been
- 13 consultation between the Majority Leader and the Minority
- Leader; and be it further 14
- 15 RESOLVED, That, after consultation between the Majority
- Leader and the Minority Leader, if the process permitted for 16
- 17 designated voting under this temporary rule is not agreed upon,
- 18 the vote shall be cast pursuant to the Rules of the House of
- Representatives in existence on March 15, 2020; and be it 19
- further 2.0

- 1 RESOLVED, That if a designated Whip is on leave, that
- 2 designated Whip may appoint another member to cast all votes
- 3 designated to that Whip; and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That a designation shall be accomplished by filing
- 5 an attestation with the Chief Clerk which affirms that the
- 6 member will not be present in the Hall of the House and
- 7 identifies either the Majority or Minority Whip as the designee;
- 8 and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That a designation shall also include a
- 10 commencement date and an expiration date; and be it further
- 11 RESOLVED, That a member may revoke the member's designation
- 12 by notifying the Chief Clerk in writing of the revocation; and
- 13 be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, That a member voting by designation under this
- 15 temporary rule shall be counted in determining whether a quorum
- 16 is present; and be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That a designation shall be effective until the
- 18 designation expires or is revoked or until this temporary rule
- 19 expires; and be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That, at any voting meeting of a committee of the
- 21 House of Representatives, a member of the committee who is not
- 22 present may designate the chair or minority chair to cast the
- 23 member's vote on any question; and be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That the designation shall be accomplished by
- 25 filing an attestation with the chair or minority chair which
- 26 affirms that the member will not be present at the voting
- 27 meeting; and be it further
- 28 RESOLVED, That a member voting by designation under this
- 29 temporary rule shall be counted in determining whether a quorum
- 30 is present; and be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That a bill may not receive action on concurrence
- 2 until at least three hours have elapsed from the time the bill
- 3 and its amendatory language was available to the public, unless
- 4 the amendment was a technical amendment as described under the
- 5 first paragraph of Rule 24 or an affirmative vote of 2/3 of the
- 6 members elected to the House indicates that they have had
- 7 sufficient time to review the language and thereby approve
- 8 proceeding with the bill; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That members shall be notified and conference
- 10 committee reports shall be made available to members at least
- 11 three hours prior to the adoption of all conference committee
- 12 reports; and be it further
- 13 RESOLVED, That a bill may not receive action on final passage
- 14 until at least three hours have elapsed from the time the bill
- 15 and its amendatory language was available to the public, unless
- 16 the amendment was a technical amendment permitted under the
- 17 first paragraph of Rule 24 or an affirmative vote of 2/3 of the
- 18 members elected to the House indicates that they have had
- 19 sufficient time to review the language of the bill and thereby
- 20 approve proceeding with the bill; and be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That all requests for reimbursement out of any
- 22 appropriation payable to a member, nonmember officer or employee
- 23 shall be void if not submitted within 180 days of the date that
- 24 the otherwise allowable expense is incurred for any and all
- 25 otherwise allowable expenses. This Resolved Clause shall apply
- 26 to a request for reimbursement of an expense incurred beginning
- 27 January 1, 2020, and ending 180 days after the declaration of
- 28 disaster emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, is
- 29 terminated by executive order, proclamation or operation of law;
- 30 and be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That, unless amended or revoked by the House, the
- 2 temporary rules adopted in this resolution shall expire upon
- 3 expiration of the legislative term; and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That the temporary Rule adopted March 16, 2020, be
- 5 repealed.
