A RESOLUTION

- 1 Censuring Representative Russ Diamond.
- 2 WHEREAS, During the COVID-19 global pandemic, Representative
- 3 Russ Diamond has made repeated public and transphobic attacks on
- 4 Pennsylvania Secretary of Health, Dr. Rachel Levine, a
- 5 transgender woman; and
- 6 WHEREAS, On July 29, following an extensive plea by the
- 7 Secretary of Health to stop the continued transphobic and
- 8 homophobic attacks against her, Representative Diamond publicly
- 9 mocked and mimicked the Secretary of Health's plea in a
- 10 statement released to the press and to the public via social
- 11 media; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Representative Diamond parroted and ridiculed the
- 13 Secretary of Health's calls for tolerance and acceptance of the
- 14 LGBTQ+ community, which still has no Statewide protection from
- 15 discrimination and faces unprecedented discrimination and
- 16 violence across this Commonwealth, by substituting the words

- 1 "unmasked community" for "LGBTQ+ communities" from a statement
- 2 made by the Secretary of Health; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Representative Diamond has made his objection to the
- 4 science, medicine and public health expertise that supports
- 5 Governor Wolf and Secretary Levine's statewide mask order; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Representative Diamond's general disdain for the
- 7 Secretary of Health has been well documented in his written
- 8 comments and legislative measures to impede the Secretary of
- 9 Health's authority in the Commonwealth; and
- 10 WHEREAS, That disdain has grown beyond any and all
- 11 professional disagreement or objection and is now manifest in
- 12 the type of discrimination and bigotry that the Pennsylvania
- 13 General Assembly and the population of Pennsylvania, as a whole,
- 14 must condemn in the strongest terms; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Representative Diamond's attacks on Secretary Levine
- 16 and the larger LGBTQ+ communities across Pennsylvania have made
- 17 her and other LGBTQ+ citizens fearful for their own safety
- 18 merely because they were exercising their constitutional right
- 19 to live authentic lives; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Representative Diamond also used his elected
- 21 position to intimidate, mock and ridicule the Secretary of
- 22 Health and others who identify as LGBTQ+ in this Commonwealth;
- 23 and
- 24 WHEREAS, Under section 11 of Article II of the Constitution
- 25 of Pennsylvania, the House of Representatives has the exclusive
- 26 power to determine its rules, protect its members against
- 27 violence and expel a member; therefore be it
- 28 RESOLVED, That, pursuant to section 11 of Article II of the
- 29 Constitution of Pennsylvania, the House of Representatives
- 30 censure Representative Russ Diamond for his actions, which tend

- 1 to bring the House of Representatives into dishonor and
- 2 disrepute; and be it further
- 3 RESOLVED, That, pursuant to section 11 of Article II of the
- 4 Constitution of Pennsylvania, the House of Representatives
- 5 remove Representative Russ Diamond from his position as a member
- 6 of the Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee, the Finance
- 7 Committee, the Gaming Oversight Committee and the State
- 8 Government Committee; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct that for
- 10 the remainder of the 2019-2020 Legislative Session, the House
- 11 not appoint Representative Russ Diamond to any standing, select
- 12 or special committee of the House, the General Assembly or any
- 13 agency, authority, board or commission.
