A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of October 2020 as "Energy Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, President George H. W. Bush first declared October
- 4 as "National Energy Awareness Month" in 1991; and
- 5 WHEREAS, President Bush encouraged the Federal Government and
- 6 organizations to recognize the importance of responsibly
- 7 managing the nation's energy resources; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The United States has taken great strides toward
- 9 energy efficiency by developing and promoting energy-efficient
- 10 products in homes; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The use of energy-efficient products has reduced
- 12 consumer utility bills; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Federal Government and the Commonwealth have
- 14 promoted energy efficiency; and
- 15 WHEREAS, According to the United States Energy Information
- 16 Administration (EIA), Pennsylvania:
- 17 (1) is the second-largest natural gas producer in the

- 1 United States;
- 2 (2) is the second-largest net supplier of total energy
- 3 to other states;
- 4 (3) is the third-largest coal producing state; and
- 5 (4) ranks third in electricity generation and, in 2018,
- 6 nuclear power was the largest electricity generator in this
- 7 Commonwealth;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, The EIA reports that as of 2018, approximately 51%
- 10 of Pennsylvania households used natural gas as their primary
- 11 home heating fuel, 22% used electricity and 24% used fuel oil
- 12 and other heating fuels, including propane and wood; and
- 13 WHEREAS, According to the EIA, Pennsylvania's first
- 14 commercial wind farm started generating electricity in 2000, and
- 15 this Commonwealth currently has 24 operating wind farms with
- 16 approximately 1,400 megawatts of capacity; and
- 17 WHEREAS, According to the Solar Energies Industries
- 18 Association, Pennsylvania had approximately 68,000 homes powered
- 19 by solar energy, there were approximately 4,200 solar jobs as of
- 20 2019 and approximately \$179,000,000 were invested in 2019 in
- 21 this Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 23 month of October 2020 as "Energy Awareness Month" in
- 24 Pennsylvania.
