Section 1105(b)(6) of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 1105. Statement of financial interests. * * * 10 11 (b) Required information. -- The statement shall include the 12 following information for the prior calendar year with regard to 13 the person required to file the statement: * * * 14

15 The name and address of the source and the amount of 16 any gift or gifts valued in the aggregate at \$250 or more and 17 the circumstances of each gift. This paragraph shall not 18 apply to a gift or gifts received from a spouse, parent, parent by marriage, sibling, child, grandchild[,] or other 19

- family member [or friend] when the circumstances make it
- 2 clear that the motivation for the action was a personal or
- family relationship. [However, for the purposes of this
- 4 paragraph, the term "friend" shall not include a registered
- lobbyist or an employee of a registered lobbyist.]

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
