## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 10, 1990 (P.L.404, No.98), entitled "An 1 act providing for the certification of real estate 2 appraisers; specifying requirements for certification; 3 providing for sanctions and penalties; and making an appropriation," further providing for definitions and for 5 State Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of July 10, 1990 (P.L.404, No.98), known as the Real Estate Appraisers Certification Act, 10 11 is amended by adding definitions to read:

- 18 current valid certificate issued under the act of April 16, 1992
- 19 (P.L.155, No.28), known as the Assessors Certification Act.

- 4 Section 2. Section 4(a) and (b) of the act are amended and
- 5 the section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 6 Section 4. State Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers.
- 7 (a) Creation. -- There is hereby created the State Board of
- 8 Certified Real Estate Appraisers as a departmental
- 9 administrative board in the Department of State. The board shall
- 10 consist of the following members:
- 11 (1) The Secretary of the Commonwealth or a designee.
- 12 (2) The Attorney General or a designee.
- 13 (3) The Secretary of Banking or a designee.
- 14 (4) [Eight] <u>Ten</u> members who are citizens of the United
- 15 States and who have been residents of this Commonwealth for a
- two-year period immediately prior to appointment[, two of
- whom shall be public members and six]. Six of [whom] the
- 18 <u>members</u> shall be [persons who are] State-certified real
- 19 estate appraisers[.], two of the members shall be certified
- 20 <u>Pennsylvania evaluators and two of the members shall be</u>
- 21 public members. Nothing in this paragraph shall prohibit the
- 22 <u>appointment of a professional member who is a certified</u>
- 23 <u>Pennsylvania evaluator and also a State-certified real estate</u>
- 24 appraiser, except that the appointment shall specify in which
- 25 capacity the member is being appointed.
- 26 (b) Term of office. -- The professional and public members
- 27 shall serve four-year terms, except as provided in subsection
- 28 (c) or (c.1), and shall be appointed by the Governor by and with
- 29 the advice and consent of a majority of the members elected to
- 30 the Senate.

- 2 (c.1) Initial appointments of certified Pennsylvania
- 3 evaluators. -- Within 90 days of the effective date of this
- 4 <u>subsection</u>, the Governor shall nominate one certified
- 5 <u>Pennsylvania evaluator to serve a two-year term and one</u>
- 6 <u>certified Pennsylvania evaluator to serve a four-year term.</u>

- 8 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
