Amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), entitled "An act defining the liability of an employer to pay damages for 1 2 injuries received by an employe in the course of employment; 3 establishing an elective schedule of compensation; providing procedure for the determination of liability and compensation 5 thereunder; and prescribing penalties," in health and safety, further providing for certification of safety committee. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1002(a) of the act of June 2, 1915 11 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, is 12 amended AND THE SECTION IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SUBSECTION to <--13 read: 14 Section 1002. (a) An insured employer may make application 15 to the department for the certification of any established 16 safety committee operative within its workplace developed for 17 the purpose of hazard detection [and], accident prevention and 18 providing information regarding the risks associated with opioid 19 painkiller use. The department shall develop such certification 20 criteria.
