- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in high schools, further providing 5 for courses of study. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1605 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 10 11 amended by adding a subsection to read: 12 Section 1605. Courses of Study. -- * * * 13 (d) (1) Beginning with students graduating from a public 14 high school at the end of the 2020-2021 school year, and continuing in each school year thereafter, a student who

- 16 successfully completes a course in personal finance during
- 17 grades nine through twelve shall be permitted to apply up to one
- 18 credit earned for successful completion of the course to satisfy
- the student's social studies, family and consumer science, 19
- mathematics or business education credit requirement for 20

- 1 graduation, provided that the governing body of the student's
- 2 <u>public high school shall have discretion to determine the</u>
- 3 graduation credit requirement to which the credit earned by the
- 4 student shall be applied.
- 5 (2) As used in this subsection, the following words and
- 6 phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this paragraph
- 7 <u>unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 8 <u>"Personal finance." The integration of various factors</u>
- 9 relating to personal financial management, including
- 10 understanding financial institutions, using money, learning to
- 11 manage personal assets and liabilities, creating budgets and any
- 12 other factors that may assist an individual in this Commonwealth
- 13 to be financially responsible.
- 14 "Public high school." A public school, including a school
- 15 within a school district, a charter school, a cyber charter
- 16 school, a regional charter school or a career and technical
- 17 school, that offers twelfth grade.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
