## AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in inspection of vehicles, further providing for
- requirement for periodic inspection of vehicles.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4702(f) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by
- 8 adding subsections to read:
- 9 § 4702. Requirement for periodic inspection of vehicles.
- 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (f) [Emission] <u>Biennial</u> inspection. -- Subject vehicles
- 12 operated in this Commonwealth must be emission inspected as
- 13 provided in section 4706 (relating to prohibition on
- 14 expenditures for emission inspection program)[.], and vehicle
- 15 <u>emission inspection of subject vehicles</u>, <u>unless exempted from</u>
- 16 the requirements for emission inspection under subsection (g),
- 17 shall be on a biennial basis. Starting January 1 for when a
- 18 biennial emission inspection is allowed following the approval

- 1 <u>in subsection (i)</u>, vehicles manufactured in an odd-numbered year
- 2 <u>shall receive an emission inspection during an odd-numbered</u>
- 3 year, and vehicles manufactured in an even-numbered year shall
- 4 receive an emission inspection during an even-numbered year. The
- 5 <u>department shall notify the official inspection stations on a</u>
- 6 periodic basis of the staggered biennial emission inspections.

- 8 (h) Notification to Environmental Protection Agency. -- The
- 9 Department of Environmental Protection shall notify the
- 10 Environmental Protection Agency of the modifications to the
- 11 <u>vehicle emission program in subsection (f) and of the intent to</u>
- 12 seek its approval of the plan in accordance with the
- 13 requirements of Federal law. The department shall notify the
- 14 chair and minority chair of the Transportation Committee of the
- 15 Senate, the chair and minority chair of the Transportation
- 16 Committee of the House of Representatives, the chair and
- 17 minority chair of the Environmental Resources and Energy
- 18 Committee of the Senate and the chair and minority chair of the
- 19 Environmental Resources and Energy Committee of the House of
- 20 Representatives of the department's notification to the
- 21 Environmental Protection Agency.
- 22 (i) Notice of approval. -- Upon approval by the Environmental
- 23 Protection Agency under subsection (h), the secretary shall
- 24 transmit notice of the approval to the Legislative Reference
- 25 Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
