## AN ACT

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| 7                          | The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania   |
| 8                          | hereby enacts as follows:  |
| 9                          | Section 1. Section 3 heading, (a) and (b) of the act of May  |
| 10                         | 30, 2012 (P.L.574, No.59), known as the Sudden Cardiac Arrest  |
| 11                         | Prevention Act, are amended to read:   |
| 12                         | Section 3. Sudden cardiac arrest and electrocardiogram testing.  |
| 13                         | (a) Educational materials  |
| 14                         | (1) The department and the Department of Education shall   |
| 15                         | develop and post on their publicly accessible Internet   |
| 16                         | websites guidelines and other relevant materials to inform   |
| 17                         | and educate students participating in or desiring to   |
| 18                         | participate in an athletic activity, their parents and their   |
| 19                         | coaches about [the] <u>:</u>   |
| 20                         | (i) The nature and warning signs of sudden cardiac   |

1 arrest, including the risks associated with continuing to 2 play or practice after experiencing one or more symptoms of sudden cardiac arrest, including fainting, difficulty 3 breathing, chest pains, dizziness and abnormal racing 4 5 heart rate.

(ii) Information about electrocardiogram testing. (iii) The option to request the administration of an 7 electrocardiogram, in addition to the comprehensive initial preparticipation physical examination.

In developing the guidelines and materials, the 10 (2)department and the Department of Education may utilize 11 12 existing materials developed by organizations such as Parent 13 Heart Watch and Sudden Arrhythmia Death Syndromes.

14 A student participating in or desiring to (3) 15 participate in an athletic activity and the student's parent 16 or quardian shall, each school year and prior to 17 participation by the student in an athletic activity, sign 18 and return to the student's school an acknowledgment of 19 receipt and review of a sudden cardiac arrest symptoms and 20 warning signs information sheet that includes information about electrocardiogram testing developed under this 21 22 subsection.

23 (b) Informational meeting. -- A school entity may hold an 24 informational meeting prior to the start of each athletic season for all ages of competitors regarding the symptoms and warning 25 26 signs of sudden cardiac arrest and information about 27 electrocardiogram testing. In addition to students, parents, coaches and other school officials, informational meetings may 28 29 include physicians, pediatric cardiologists and athletic 30 trainers.

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- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
