Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in licensing of drivers, further providing for 2 issuance and content of driver's license. Section 1510 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding subsections to read: 8 § 1510. Issuance and content of driver's license. 9 (d.1) Deafness or hearing impairment designation. --10 11 (1) An individual who is deaf or has a hearing 12 impairment may request to have a deafness or hearing 13 impairment identifier symbol placed on the individual's 14 driver's license or identification card. 15 (2) The individual shall present the department with a sworn statement signed by a qualified medical professional 16 certifying that the individual is deaf or has a hearing 17
