7	Section 1. Section 916(a) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by

10	§ 916. Problem-solving courts.
11	(a) EstablishmentThe court of common pleas of a judicial
12	district and the Municipal Court of Philadelphia may establish,
13	from available funds, one or more problem-solving courts which
14	have specialized jurisdiction, including, but not limited to,
15	veterans courts, drug courts, mental health courts and driving
16	under the influence courts, whereby defendants are admitted to a
17	court-supervised individualized treatment program. The court may
18	adopt local rules for the administration of problem-solving

courts and their related treatment services. The local rules may
not be inconsistent with this section or any rules established
by the Supreme Court.

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5 (d) Veterans courts.--

6 (1) If a court of common pleas OF A JUDICIAL DISTRICT or <--
7 the Municipal Court of Philadelphia has established a

8 veterans court under subsection (a), the court may provide

9 for participation by defendants from adjacent counties

10 ANOTHER COUNTY OR COUNTIES.

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11 (2) A court of common pleas OF A JUDICIAL DISTRICT or <--

13 adjacent counties THE COURT IN ANOTHER COUNTY OR COUNTIES to <--

the Municipal Court of Philadelphia may join with courts in

14 <u>establish a multicounty veterans court.</u>

15 <u>(e) Veterans track.--If a court of common pleas OF A</u> <--

16 JUDICIAL DISTRICT or the Municipal Court of Philadelphia

17 established a problem-solving court under subsection (a), except

18 for a veterans court, the court may establish a veterans track

19 within the problem-solving court. As used in this subsection,

20 the term "veterans track" means a program that utilizes some

21 components of a veterans court, including, but not limited to,

22 treatment resources and veteran mentors and does not have the

23 population and judicial resources to sustain of a full veterans <--

24 <u>court.</u>

(f) Local rules.--A court of common pleas OF A JUDICIAL
DISTRICT or the Municipal Court of Philadelphia that established
a veterans court, multicounty veterans court or veterans track
under this section may adopt local rules for the administration
of the courts and their related treatment services. The local

30 rules may not be inconsistent with this section or any rules

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1 established by the Supreme Court.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
