## AN ACT

Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, in minors, further providing for the offense of 3 sexual abuse of children; and, in sentencing, further 4 providing for sentencing for offenses involving sexual abuse 5 of children. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 6312(d.1) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 10 § 6312. Sexual abuse of children. 11 \* \* \* 12 (d.1) Grading. -- The offenses shall be graded as follows: 13 14 Except as provided in paragraph (3), an offense 15 under subsection (b) is a felony of the second degree. 16 (2) (i) Except as provided in paragraph (3), a first 17 offense under subsection (c) or (d) is a felony of the 18 third degree. 19 (ii) A second or subsequent offense under subsection

(c) or (d) is a felony of the second degree.

- 2 paragraph (1) or (2) (i) [and indecent contact with the child
- as defined in section 3101 (relating to definitions) is
- depicted], the grading of the offense shall be one grade
- 5 higher than the grade specified in paragraph (1) or (2)(i)[.]

- 7 <u>(i) indecent contact with the child as defined in</u>
- 8 <u>section 3101 (relating to definitions) is depicted; or</u>

- 12 Section 2. Section 9720.5 of Title 42 is amended to read:
- 13 § 9720.5. Sentencing for offenses involving sexual abuse of
- 14 children.
- 15 (a) General rule. -- The Pennsylvania Commission on
- 16 Sentencing, in accordance with section 2154 (relating to
- 17 adoption of guidelines for sentencing), shall provide for a
- 18 sentence enhancement within its guidelines for an offense under
- 19 18 Pa.C.S. § 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children),
- 20 specifying variations from the range of sentences applicable
- 21 based on such aggravating circumstances as the age of the child
- 22 or a determination of prepubescence, the number of images
- 23 possessed by the defendant, if the child depicted is known to
- 24 the defendant and the nature and character of the abuse depicted
- 25 in the images.
- 26 (b) Other circumstances. -- When a person commits an offense
- 27 to which the grading provisions under 18 Pa.C.S. § 6312(d.1)(3)
- 28 apply, the Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing shall, in
- 29 accordance with section 2154, provide for a sentence enhancement
- 30 within its guidelines if indecent contact with the child as

- 2 <u>depicted and the child depicted is under six years of age or</u>
- 3 <u>prepubescent.</u>
- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
