AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in sentencing, further providing for payment of court costs, restitution and fines. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 9730 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
§ 9730. Payment of court costs, restitution and fines. * * *
(c) Judicial emergencies.--
(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, during the time period of a judicial emergency declared under Article $V$ of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, a law of this Commonwealth, a rule of court or other judicial order by the Supreme Court or any agency or unit of the unified judicial system exercising a power or performing a duty in accordance with section 1721 (relating to delegation of powers), the failure to pay court costs, restitution or fines otherwise
due during the declared judicial emergency shall not be considered a default for the purposes of this section. A defendant shall have an additional 30 days after the expiration of the declared judicial emergency to pay court costs, restitution or fines otherwise due. The failure to pay court costs, restitution or fines otherwise due during the additional 30-day period specified under this paragraph shall be considered a default for the purposes of this section. (2) This subsection shall apply to any judicial district for which a judicial emergency is declared. If a Statewide judicial emergency is declared, this subsection shall apply to all judicial districts. This subsection shall be retroactive to March 18, 2020. Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
