- 1 Services Grant Program is established and shall be administered
- 2 by the agency. Grants provided under the program shall be used
- 3 by fire companies and EMS companies to provide services during
- 4 the novel coronavirus pandemic as identified in the proclamation
- 5 of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020,
- 6 published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and any renewal of
- 7 the state of disaster emergency.

- 18 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of
- 19 \$30,000,000 shall be allocated from money received by the
- 20 <u>Commonwealth under the Federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and</u>
- 21 Economic Security Act (Public Law 116-136) for purposes of
- 22 making grants under Subchapter C.1 (relating to COVID-19 Crisis
- 23 Fire Company and Emergency Medical Services Grant Program). The
- 24 <u>following shall apply:</u>
- 25 (1) The sum of \$27,000,000 of the amount allocated shall
- 26 <u>be expended for the purpose of making grants to eligible fire</u>
- companies.
- 28 (2) The sum of \$3,000,000 of the amount allocated shall
- be expended for the purpose of making grants to eligible EMS

- 2 may use up to \$200,000 of unencumbered funds from the amount

- 7 <u>Program.</u>
- 8 The authority of the agency to award grants under Subchapter
- 9 <u>C.1 (relating to COVID-19 Crisis Fire Company and Emergency</u>
- 10 <u>Medical Services Grant Program</u>) shall expire six months after
- 11 the effective date of this section.
- 12 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
