A JOINT RESOLUTION

6	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7	hereby resolves as follows:
8	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of <
9	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
10	SECTION 1. THE FOLLOWING SEPARATE AND DISTINCT AMENDMENTS TO <
11	THE CONSTITUTION OF PENNSYLVANIA ARE PROPOSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH
12	ARTICLE XI:
13	(1) THAT ARTICLE I OF THE CONSTITUTION OF PENNSYLVANIA BE
14	AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO READ:
15	<u>§ 29. PROHIBITION AGAINST DENIAL OR ABRIDGMENT OF EQUALITY OF</u>
16	RIGHTS BECAUSE OF RACE AND ETHNICITY.
17	EQUALITY OF RIGHTS UNDER THE LAW SHALL NOT BE DENIED OR
18	ABRIDGED IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA BECAUSE OF THE RACE

1 OR ETHNICITY OF THE INDIVIDUAL.

2	(2) That Article IV be amended by adding a section to read:
3	<u>§ 20. Disaster emergency duration.</u>
4	The Governor may issue emergency declarations under
5	circumstances provided for by law for that purpose. The General
6	Assembly may by law grant the Governor certain enumerated powers
7	to address and abate the declared emergency. A declaration by
8	the Governor of an emergency shall not last longer than 30 days
9	unless extended by a concurrent resolution of the General
10	Assembly approving the continuation of the declaration. Upon the
11	expiration of the Governor's emergency declaration, the Governor
12	may not declare a new state of emergency based upon the same or
13	substantially similar facts and circumstances without the
14	passage of a concurrent resolution of the General Assembly
15	expressly approving the new emergency declaration.
16	Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General <
17	Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
18	Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to-
19	comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article-
20	XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
21	required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
22	which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
23	passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.
24	(b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
25	proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the
26	Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
27	advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the-
28	Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
29	advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
30	newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of

2 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment-

3 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first

4 primary, general or municipal election which meets the

5 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article-

6 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least-

7 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is

8 passed by the General Assembly.

9 SECTION 2. (A) UPON THE FIRST PASSAGE BY THE GENERAL <---10 ASSEMBLY OF THESE PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS, THE 11 SECRETARY OF THE COMMONWEALTH SHALL PROCEED IMMEDIATELY TO 12 COMPLY WITH THE ADVERTISING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 1 OF ARTICLE XI OF THE CONSTITUTION OF PENNSYLVANIA AND SHALL TRANSMIT THE 13 REQUIRED ADVERTISEMENTS TO TWO NEWSPAPERS IN EVERY COUNTY IN 14 WHICH SUCH NEWSPAPERS ARE PUBLISHED IN SUFFICIENT TIME AFTER 15 PASSAGE OF THESE PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS. 16

(B) UPON THE SECOND PASSAGE BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THESE 17 18 PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS, THE SECRETARY OF THE COMMONWEALTH SHALL PROCEED IMMEDIATELY TO COMPLY WITH THE 19 20 ADVERTISING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 1 OF ARTICLE XI OF THE 21 CONSTITUTION OF PENNSYLVANIA AND SHALL TRANSMIT THE REQUIRED ADVERTISEMENTS TO TWO NEWSPAPERS IN EVERY COUNTY IN WHICH SUCH 22 23 NEWSPAPERS ARE PUBLISHED IN SUFFICIENT TIME AFTER PASSAGE OF THESE PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS. THE SECRETARY OF THE 24 25 COMMONWEALTH SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT THE PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT UNDER
SECTION 1(1) OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF
THIS COMMONWEALTH AS A SEPARATE BALLOT QUESTION AT THE FIRST
PRIMARY, GENERAL OR MUNICIPAL ELECTION WHICH MEETS THE
REQUIREMENTS OF AND IS IN CONFORMANCE WITH SECTION 1 OF

ARTICLE XI OF THE CONSTITUTION OF PENNSYLVANIA AND WHICH
 OCCURS AT LEAST THREE MONTHS AFTER THE PROPOSED
 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT IS PASSED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

4 (2) SUBMIT THE PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT UNDER SECTION 1(2) OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF 5 6 THIS COMMONWEALTH AS A SEPARATE BALLOT QUESTION AT THE FIRST PRIMARY, GENERAL OR MUNICIPAL ELECTION WHICH MEETS THE 7 REQUIREMENTS OF AND IS IN CONFORMANCE WITH SECTION 1 OF 8 9 ARTICLE XI OF THE CONSTITUTION OF PENNSYLVANIA AND WHICH OCCURS AT LEAST THREE MONTHS AFTER THE PROPOSED 10 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT IS PASSED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY. 11
