- 23 (a) Establishment. The COVID-19 Emergency Agricultural Fair <--
- 24 Grant Program is established and shall be administered by the
- 25 department. Grants provided under the program shall be used to
- 26 assist county agricultural societies, independent agricultural
- 27 <u>societies or other organizations impacted by the COVID-19</u>
- 28 disaster emergency as provided under this section.

 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and any renewal of the state of

 emergency.
