AN ACT

1 Designating the bridge on Locust Road over Dixon Run in Green
2 Township, Indiana County, as the Technician Fourth Grade
3 William Balogh Memorial Bridge.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. The Technician Fourth Grade William Balogh Memorial
7 Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
9 follows:

10 (1) Technician Fourth Grade William Balogh honorably
11 served his country during World War II.

12 (2) Balogh served with the United States Army,
13 Headquarters Company, 3rd Battalion, 112th Infantry from
14 April 25, 1941, to July 24, 1945.

15 (3) Balogh was detained as a prisoner of war by the
16 Germans at Stalag 9B Bad Orb Hessen-Nassau, Prussia 50-IX.

17 (4) For his service, Balogh received a Good Conduct
18 Medal, American Defense Service Medal and European African
19 Middle Eastern Service Ribbon.

1 (5) Balogh was honorably discharged from the United
2 States Army in 1945.

3 (b) Designation.--The bridge on Locust Road over Dixon Run
4 in Green Township, Indiana County, is designated as the
5 Technician Fourth Grade William Balogh Memorial Bridge.

6 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
7 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
8 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

9 Section 2. Effective date.

10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
