## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, No.1), entitled "An act establishing a system of 2 unemployment compensation to be administered by the 3 Department of Labor and Industry and its existing and newly 4 created agencies with personnel (with certain exceptions) 5 selected on a civil service basis; requiring employers to keep records and make reports, and certain employers to pay 6 7 contributions based on payrolls to provide moneys for the 8 payment of compensation to certain unemployed persons; 9 10 providing procedure and administrative details for the determination, payment and collection of such contributions 11 and the payment of such compensation; providing for 12 cooperation with the Federal Government and its agencies; 13 creating certain special funds in the custody of the State 14 Treasurer; and prescribing penalties," in compensation, 15 providing for receipt of personal identification number. 16 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 18 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937) 19 20 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the Unemployment Compensation Law, is 21 amended by adding a section to read: 22 Section 401.1. Receipt of Personal Identification Number .--23 (a) Upon receipt of an application for benefits by the 24 department, the department shall provide a personal

identification number (PIN) to all claimants in order to access

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- 1 <u>information relating to the claimant's claim on the department's</u>
- 2 <u>Internet claims filing system or through the PA Teleclaims</u>
- 3 telephone system. The claimant's PIN shall be provided to the
- 4 <u>claimant through mail and electronic mail, if applicable.</u>
- 5 (b) The department shall create a secure method of
- 6 <u>delivering each PIN to the claimant through electronic mail, if</u>
- 7 applicable. The department shall transmit notice of the
- 8 completion of the secure delivery method under this subsection
- 9 to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the
- 10 Pennsylvania Bulletin within thirty (30) days of the effective
- 11 date of this section.
- 12 Section 2. The addition of section 401.1 of the act shall
- 13 apply to claims filed on or after the effective date of this
- 14 section.
- 15 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
