- Amending the act of July 8, 1978 (P.L.752, No.140), entitled "An act providing for the forfeiture of the pensions of certain 2 public employees and authorizing the State or political 3 subdivision to garnish the pension benefits of certain public officers and employees upon conviction of certain criminal 5 activity related to their office or position of employment," further providing for definitions and for disqualification and forfeiture of benefits. 6 7 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 11 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of July 8, 1978 (P.L.752, 12 No.140), known as the Public Employee Pension Forfeiture Act, is 13 amended by adding a definition to read: Section 2. Definitions. 14 15 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 16 have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the 17 meanings given to them in this section: 18 "Crime of moral turpitude." - 22 Section 2. Section 3(a) of the act, amended March 28, 2019
- 23 (P.L.1, No.1), is amended to read:
- 24 Section 3. Disqualification and forfeiture of benefits.
- 25 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no public
- 26 official or public employee nor any beneficiary designated by
- 27 such public official or public employee shall be entitled to
- 28 receive any retirement or other benefit or payment of any kind
- 29 except a return of the contribution paid into any pension fund
- 30 without interest, if such public official or public employee is

- 1 found guilty of a crime:
- 2 (1) related to public office or public employment or pleads
- 3 guilty or nolo contendere to any crime related to public office
- 4 or public employment[.]; or
- 5 (2) of moral turpitude or pleads quilty or nolo contendere
- 6 to a crime of moral turpitude, which was committed during the
- 7 term of office or employment of the public official or public
- 8 <u>employee</u>.

- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
