Short title. 9 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Supplement to 10 the General Appropriation Act of 2020. Section 101.1. Intent. 11 It is the intent of this general appropriation act to provide 12 13 funding for the remainder of fiscal year July 1, 2020, to June 14 30, 2021. Section 102. Definitions. 15 16 The definitions in the act of May 29, 2020 (P.L. , No.1A), known as the General Appropriation Act of 2020, shall apply to 17 18 this act. 19 Section 103. Abbreviations. 20 The abbreviations in the act of May 29, 2020 (P.L., No.1A), known as the General Appropriation Act of 2020, shall apply to 21 this act, and the following abbreviations when used in this act 22 23 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 24 context clearly indicates otherwise: 25 "CDBG." Community Development Block Grant. "ESG." Emergency Solutions Grant. 26 "LIHEAP." Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program. 27 28 Section 104. State appropriations. 29 (a) General Fund.--Except as provided in Part LI, the sums 30 specified in this act, or as much thereof as may be necessary,

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are specifically appropriated from the General Fund to agencies 1 2 of the Executive Department of the Commonwealth for the payment 3 of salaries, wages or other compensation and travel expenses of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees of the 4 Commonwealth, for the payment of fees for contractual services 5 6 rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods and services, 7 printing, public advertising by or through any medium, 8 equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for the 9 10 proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and for 11 the purposes specified in this act for the current fiscal year 12 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at 13 the close of the prior fiscal year.
