A SUPPLEMENT

1 To the act of May 29, 2020 (P.L. , No.1A), entitled "An act
2 to provide appropriations from the General Fund for the
3 expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial
4 Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and the
5 public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2020, to June 30,
6 2021, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining
7 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020;
8 to provide appropriations from special funds and accounts to
9 the Executive and Judicial Departments for the fiscal year
10 July 1, 2020, to June 30, 2021, and for the payment of bills
11 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June
12 30, 2020; to provide for the appropriation of Federal funds
13 to the Executive and Judicial Departments for the fiscal year
14 July 1, 2020, to June 30, 2021, and for the payment of bills
15 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June
16 30, 2020; and to provide for the additional appropriation of
17 Federal and State funds to the Executive and Judicial
18 Departments for the fiscal year July 1, 2019, to June 30,
19 2020, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining
20 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019,"
21 further providing for additional appropriations and
22 replacement of appropriations from the General Fund and other
23 funds and accounts for the expenses of the Executive
24 Department for the fiscal year July 1, 2020, to June 30,
25 2021, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining
26 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020;
27 and providing for required lapsing of money in the General
28 Fund.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

7 GENERAL PROVISIONS

8 Section 101. Short title.

9 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Supplement to
10 the General Appropriation Act of 2020.

11 Section 101.1. Intent.

12 It is the intent of this general appropriation act to provide
13 funding for the remainder of fiscal year July 1, 2020, to June
14 30, 2021.

15 Section 102. Definitions.

16 The definitions in the act of May 29, 2020 (P.L. , No.1A),
17 known as the General Appropriation Act of 2020, shall apply to
18 this act.

19 Section 103. Abbreviations.

20 The abbreviations in the act of May 29, 2020 (P.L. , No.1A),
21 known as the General Appropriation Act of 2020, shall apply to
22 this act, and the following abbreviations when used in this act
23 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
24 context clearly indicates otherwise:

25 "CDBG." Community Development Block Grant.

26 "ESG." Emergency Solutions Grant.

27 "LIHEAP." Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program.

28 Section 104. State appropriations.

29 (a) General Fund.--Except as provided in Part LI, the sums
30 specified in this act, or as much thereof as may be necessary,

1 are specifically appropriated from the General Fund to agencies
2 of the Executive Department of the Commonwealth for the payment
3 of salaries, wages or other compensation and travel expenses of
4 the duly elected or appointed officers and employees of the
5 Commonwealth, for the payment of fees for contractual services
6 rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods and services,
7 printing, public advertising by or through any medium,
8 equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any other
9 expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for the
10 proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and for
11 the purposes specified in this act for the current fiscal year
12 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at
13 the close of the prior fiscal year.

15 Section 105. Federal appropriations.

16 Except as otherwise provided in section 5102, the Federal
17 appropriations specified in this act, or as much thereof as may
18 be necessary, are specifically appropriated to the agencies of
19 the Executive Department of the Commonwealth specified in this
20 act for the payment of the expenses of implementing and carrying
21 out the programs specified in this act for the current fiscal
22 year and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid
23 at the close of the prior fiscal year. Unless otherwise stated,
24 the Federal appropriations include any carryovers from the prior
25 fiscal year.

5 SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR FEDERAL FUNDS

6 FOR CURRENT FISCAL YEAR

7 Section 6101. General Fund repository for Federal funds.

8 Moneys received from the Federal Government as contributions
9 or supplements to the departments or agencies of the
10 Commonwealth or the programs provided in this act shall be paid
11 into the General Fund.

12 Section 6102. (Reserved).

13 Section 6103. Appropriation of prior unspent Federal funds.

14 (a) General rule.--Federal moneys that have been previously
15 appropriated by the General Assembly and authorized or allocated
16 by the Federal Government but remain unspent from the prior
17 fiscal year or previous fiscal years and will not be renewed for
18 the current fiscal year are appropriated.

19 (b) Department of Human Services.--The Federal
20 appropriations to the Department of Human Services include any
21 prior earnings that may be received during the current fiscal
22 year. In addition to the amounts specifically appropriated in
23 this act to the Department of Human Services, all moneys
24 appropriated from the Federal Government during a previous
25 fiscal year which are expected to be received as reimbursements
26 may be carried forward until the close of the current fiscal
27 year to the extent that obligations are carried forward. In
28 addition, reimbursements actually received to support the
29 obligations may also be carried forward.

30 Section 6104. Subgrants between Federal appropriations.

1 Subgrants may be made between Federal appropriations without
2 further approval of the General Assembly. The Secretary of the
3 Budget shall submit a list of subgrants to the chair and
4 minority chair of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate and
5 the chair and minority chair of the Appropriations Committee of
6 the House of Representatives quarterly. No subgrant to a State
7 agency, however, may be made from a restricted receipt account
8 without a specific appropriation by the General Assembly.

9 Section 6105. Utilization of emergency Federal funds.

10 (a) Natural disasters and civil disobedience.--Federal funds
11 available for costs and damages resulting from natural disasters
12 or civil disobedience may be added to an appropriation contained
13 in this act or to funds otherwise appropriated or may be used
14 for the purposes prescribed by the Federal Government.

15 (b) Other emergencies.--In addition to the moneys
16 appropriated by this act, moneys received from the Federal
17 Government for the purpose of disaster assistance or relief, or
18 other moneys received as a direct result of terrorist acts,
19 moneys for homeland security and defense and moneys for avian
20 flu/pandemic preparedness shall be paid into the General Fund
21 and are appropriated out of the General Fund to the departments,
22 boards, commissions or agencies designated by the Governor.

23 (c) Limitation.--Total expenditures from Federal funds
24 pursuant to subsections (a) and (b) shall not exceed
25 \$50,000,000. This subsection does not apply to Federal emergency
26 unemployment compensation funds or Federal highway and transit
27 funds.

29 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS FOR

30 CURRENT FISCAL YEAR

1 Section 7101. Prior laws unaffected.

2 This act is not intended to be inconsistent with or to repeal
3 any provision of any act enacted at this or any prior session of
4 the General Assembly regulating the purchase of supplies, the
5 ordering of printing and binding, the purchase, maintenance and
6 use of motor vehicles, the method of making payments from the
7 State Treasury for any purpose or the functioning of any
8 administrative department, board or commission.

9 Section 7102. Compliance with other law before funds available.

10 No appropriation made by this act to any department, board,
11 commission or agency of the Executive Department shall be
12 available unless and until the department, board, commission or
13 agency has complied with sections 615 and 616 of the act of
14 April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative
15 Code of 1929.

16 Section 7103. Contracts prerequisite to encumbering or
17 committing funds.

18 Funds available to agencies, boards, departments, commissions
19 or other governmental entities under this act for the
20 procurement of supplies, services or construction shall not be
21 available for payment of or to be committed to or encumbered for
22 payment of the procurement unless and until the agency, board,
23 department or other governmental entity has complied with all of
24 the requirements applicable to the procurement that are
25 specified in 62 Pa.C.S. (relating to procurement) and in the
26 policies, procedures and regulations instituted in accordance
27 with 62 Pa.C.S.

28 Section 7104. Minority business set-asides.

29 (a) Duty to report.--Each department or other
30 instrumentality of the Commonwealth listed in Subpart B of Part

1 II authorized to contract for buildings, highways, commodities,
2 equipment, supplies or services shall report to the General
3 Assembly all information pertinent to anticipated procurement
4 needs at the beginning of each quarter during a fiscal year.

5 (b) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "minority
6 business" means a minority business enterprise as defined in the
7 act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.598, No.206), known as the
8 Pennsylvania Minority Business Development Authority Act.

9 Section 7105. (Reserved).

10 Section 7106. Lapsing of unused funds.

11 (a) General rule.--Except as otherwise provided by law or by
12 this section, that part of all appropriations in this act
13 unexpended, uncommitted or unencumbered as of the close of the
14 current fiscal year shall automatically lapse as of that day.

15 (b) (Reserved).

16 Section 7107. Construction with prior appropriation acts.

17 Any appropriation in Subpart B of Part LI of the act of May
18 29, 2020 (P.L. , No.1A), known as the General Appropriation
19 Act of 2020, which is the same or similar to any appropriation
20 in the act of June 28, 2019 (P.L. , No.1A), known as the
21 General Appropriation Act of 2019, shall replace that
22 appropriation.

24 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

25 Section 8101. Retroactivity.

26 This act shall be retroactive to July 1, 2020.

27 Section 8102. Effective date.

28 This act shall take effect immediately.
