A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the month of September 2019 as "Ovarian Cancer
- 2 Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Ovarian cancer is the fifth leading cause of cancer-
- 4 related deaths among women; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The lifetime risk of developing the disease is 1 in
- 6 78; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The risk of dying from invasive ovarian cancer is 1
- 8 in 108; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Recent estimates of the American Cancer Society
- 10 indicate 22,530 new ovarian cancer cases and 13,980 ovarian
- 11 cancer deaths in 2019; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Early-stage ovarian cancer is difficult to detect;
- 13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, Treatment generally involves a combination of
- 15 surgery and chemotherapy; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Inhibitor drugs, radiation therapy and hormonal

- 1 therapy are other treatment options; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Early access to palliative care can extend survival
- 3 for women with advanced disease; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Targeted drugs, screening, imaging, psychological
- 5 effects and biological factors, including hereditary risk, are
- 6 areas of research; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of September
- 8 2019 as "Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
