A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Korean and Korean-American Vietnam War veterans for 2 their service to the United States during the Vietnam War.
- 3 WHEREAS, Korean and Korean-American Vietnam War veterans
- 4 served honorably throughout the conflict, fighting valiantly
- 5 both in and alongside the United States Armed Forces, often
- 6 making the ultimate sacrifice, with many later becoming United
- 7 States citizens; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The United States holds freedom, democracy and self-
- 9 determination as its highest ideals; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The alliance forged between the United States and
- 11 the Republic of Korea traces back to the Korean War; and
- 12 WHEREAS, During the Vietnam War, nearly 3,000,000 members of
- 13 the United States Armed Forces fought bravely to preserve and
- 14 defend these ideals, among them many Korean Americans who earned
- 15 citations for their heroism and honorable service; and
- 16 WHEREAS, A minimum of 58,193 members of the United States

- 1 Armed Forces were killed, more than 300,000 were wounded and
- 2 approximately 2,000 are still missing in action; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Republic of Korea joined the Vietnam War to
- 4 support the United States Armed Forces and the cause of freedom
- 5 at the request of the United States; and
- 6 WHEREAS, From 1964 until the last soldier left Saigon on
- 7 March 23, 1973, the second largest contribution of troops sent
- 8 by an ally of the United States consisted of 325,517 members of
- 9 the Republic of Korea's Armed Forces; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Republic of Korea forces fought bravely
- 11 throughout the theater and were known for their dedication,
- 12 tenacity and effectiveness on the battlefield; and
- 13 WHEREAS, In addition to those Korean Americans who served in
- 14 the United States Armed Forces during the Vietnam War, some of
- 15 whom gave their lives for their country, 5,099 Republic of Korea
- 16 troops were killed and 10,962 were injured, many in defense of
- 17 the United States and its friends and allies; and
- 18 WHEREAS, It is estimated that thousands of veterans of the
- 19 Vietnam War who fought for the cause of the United States under
- 20 the flag of the Republic of Korea currently reside in the United
- 21 States and that most of them have become United States citizens;
- 22 and
- 23 WHEREAS, It is estimated that 20% of Korean veterans of the
- 24 Vietnam War suffer from significant injuries, including post-
- 25 traumatic stress disorder, total disability and the effects of
- 26 the toxic defoliant Agent Orange; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Korean-American veterans of the Vietnam War upheld
- 28 the highest ideals of the United States through their dedicated
- 29 service and considerable sacrifices, with many continuing to
- 30 carry the visible and invisible wounds of war to this day;

- 2 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 commend Korean and Korean-American veterans of the Vietnam War
- 4 for their service to the United States; and be it further
- 5 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be presented to the
- 6 Korean-American Veterans of the Vietnam War of Pennsylvania as
- 7 an expression of the abiding gratitude of this Commonwealth for
- 8 the service and sacrifices made by Korean-American veterans of
- 9 the Vietnam War in defense of freedom and democracy.
