A RESOLUTION

1 Designating June 5, 2020, as "Class of 2020 Day" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Many graduation ceremonies across this Commonwealth
4 have been cancelled, postponed or held virtually due to the
5 COVID-19 pandemic; and

6 WHEREAS, The members of the class of 2020 have spent years in
7 school looking forward to walking across the stage and receiving
8 their diplomas; and

9 WHEREAS, Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, most, if not all,
10 2020 graduates will not get the opportunity to have a
11 traditional graduation ceremony; and

12 WHEREAS, The hard work and dedication that the students in
13 the class of 2020 have put toward earning their diplomas
14 deserves recognition; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate June 5, 2020, as "Class
16 of 2020 Day" in Pennsylvania.
