A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of June 2020 as "Cancer Survivors Recognition Month" in Pennsylvania and honoring all cancer 2
- survivors for their strength and courage in the face of this 3
- devastating illness.
- 5 WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society estimates that there
- will be 1,800,000 new cases of cancer diagnosed in the United 6
- States in 2020; and 7
- 8 WHEREAS, As a result of advances in early detection and
- treatment, cancer has become a curable disease for some and a
- 10 chronic illness for many others; and
- 11 WHEREAS, A cancer survivor is anyone living with a history of
- 12 cancer from the moment of diagnosis through the remainder of
- 13 life; and
- WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society and the National Cancer 14
- 15 Institute estimate that 16.9 million Americans with a history of
- 16 cancer are alive in the United States today; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society reported in 2020 that
- 18 there will be an estimated 80,240 new cancer cases in this

- 1 Commonwealth; and
- 2 WHEREAS, A cancer survivor can be your parent, child,
- 3 grandparent, family member, friend, coworker or neighbor; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Cancer survivorship has three distinct phases:
- 5 living with cancer, living through cancer and living beyond
- 6 cancer; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Survivorship can be both stressful and hopeful; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Surviving cancer can leave a host of problems in its
- 9 wake; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Physical, emotional and financial hardships often
- 11 persist for years after diagnosis and treatment; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Many cancer survivors are deeply grateful to their
- 13 caregivers, family, friends, health care providers and
- 14 communities for their love, dedication and support as they
- 15 battle cancer; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Despite the fear, challenges and setbacks, life
- 17 after a cancer diagnosis can be meaningful, productive and even
- 18 inspiring and triumphant; therefore be it
- 19 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of June 2020 as
- 20 "Cancer Survivors Recognition Month" in Pennsylvania in
- 21 celebration of life; and be it further
- 22 RESOLVED, That the Senate honor all cancer survivors and urge
- 23 all residents to pause and honor those who are living with a
- 24 history of cancer for their strength, courage and inspiration.
