A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of September 2020 as "Mushroom Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, American mushroom farming began on a farm in Chester
- 4 County, now recognized as the "Mushroom Capital of the World";
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has a growing and productive mushroom
- 7 agribusiness in many parts of this Commonwealth; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Thanks to its 68 mushroom farms, Pennsylvania leads
- 9 the nation in mushroom production; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania growers produced 63% of all white
- 11 mushrooms in the United States, valued at \$554.4 million; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's mushroom farms are family owned and
- 13 operated, some for as many as four generations; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Mushrooms are one of the most difficult commodities
- 15 to grow due to the intensive labor required to produce a
- 16 consistent, high-quality crop; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Modern mushroom farms are highly technical
- 18 operations that utilize computerized systems to monitor

- 1 production and safety; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Mushroom growers carefully prepare compost, generate
- 3 an indoor pasteurization process, control temperature and
- 4 humidity and harvest their crop, thanks to advancements in
- 5 technology; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The mushroom industry contributes to the
- 7 preservation of this Commonwealth's agricultural customs and
- 8 traditions; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The success of the mushroom industry contributes
- 10 greatly to the economies of Chester County and this Commonwealth
- 11 while preserving this Commonwealth's agricultural traditions and
- 12 customs; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of September
- 14 2020 as "Mushroom Month" in Pennsylvania in recognition of
- 15 Pennsylvania's thriving agriculture industry and encourage all
- 16 residents to acknowledge and celebrate the achievements of the
- 17 mushroom industry to produce an abundant, profitable mushroom
- 18 crop recognized for superior quality and its significance to
- 19 this Commonwealth's economy.
