## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 1 2 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 6 7 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 elections," in the Secretary of the Commonwealth, providing 11 for paper ballot specifications. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known 16 as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding a section to read: 17 18 Section 209. Paper Ballot Specifications. -- (a) 19 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, each paper ballot 20 for an election shall: 21 (1) Include a timing mark, barcode, quick response code or similar measure designed to ensure greater ballot security in 22

- 1 the counting and tallying of ballots.
- 2 (2) Be designed with specific standards regarding the
- 3 length, width, weight, capacity, codes and watermark, as
- 4 <u>determined by the Secretary of the Commonwealth, in consultation</u>
- 5 with county boards.
- 6 (b) The Secretary of the Commonwealth, in consultation with
- 7 county boards, shall consider whether the standards under this
- 8 <u>section shall be applied on a Statewide or countywide basis or</u>
- 9 only within specific election districts, in light of ballot
- 10 security issues that could reasonably occur in an election or
- 11 that have occurred in past elections.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall apply to elections occurring more
- 13 than 90 days after the effective date of this section.
- 14 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
