AN ACT

- Relating to the administration and distribution of COVID-19 vaccinations in this Commonwealth.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the COVID-19
- 7 Vaccine Administration and Distribution Act.
- 8 Section 2. Administration.
- 9 Notwithstanding any other act to the contrary, an individual
- 10 authorized by the United States Department of Health and Human-
- 11 Services to administer a COVID 19 vaccination shall be permitted
- 12 to administer the vaccines in this Commonwealth.
- 13 Section 3. Expiration.
- 14 This act shall expire 60 days after the termination of the
- 15 Governor's COVID 19 emergency declaration order, or December 31,-
- 16 2022, whichever is earlier.
- 17 Section 4. Effective date.
- 18 This act shall take effect immediately.

- 1 SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 2 THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES WHEN USED IN THIS ACT SHALL

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- 3 HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION UNLESS THE
- 4 CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 5 "AFFECTED COUNTY." ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (1) A COUNTY OF THE SECOND CLASS A.
- 7 (2) A COUNTY OF THE THIRD CLASS WHICH HAS ENTERED INTO
- 8 AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT TO OVERSEE THE
- 9 COVID-19 RESPONSE IN A COUNTY OF THE SECOND CLASS A.
- 10 "COVID-19." THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS AS IDENTIFIED IN THE
- 11 GOVERNOR'S PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY ISSUED ON MARCH 6,
- 12 2020, PUBLISHED AT 50 PA.B. 1644 (MARCH 21, 2020).
- 13 "COVID-19 VACCINE." A VACCINE FOR COVID-19 THAT HAS RECEIVED
- 14 AN EMERGENCY-USE AUTHORIZATION FROM THE UNITED STATES FOOD AND
- 15 DRUG ADMINISTRATION.
- 16 "MASS VACCINATION SITE." ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 17 (1) A LOCATION IN AN AFFECTED COUNTY DESIGNED TO OUICKLY
- AND EFFICIENTLY PROVIDE COVID-19 VACCINATIONS ON A MASS SCALE
- 19 TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
- 20 (2) THE TERM INCLUDES A LOCATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1),
- 21 INCLUDING A GYMNASIUM, SHOPPING CENTER, PARKING LOT, SENIOR
- 22 CENTER, HOUSE OF WORSHIP, LIBRARY, FIRE STATION OR OTHER
- 23 FACILITY NOT TYPICALLY UTILIZED FOR THE DELIVERY OF MEDICAL
- 24 SERVICES.
- 25 (3) THE TERM DOES NOT INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:
- 26 (I) A LOCATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) WHICH IS A
- 27 HOSPITAL, NURSING HOME, ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY, SKILLED
- 28 NURSING FACILITY, PHARMACY OR OTHER FACILITY WHERE THE
- 29 DELIVERY OF MEDICAL SERVICES IS TYPICALLY PERFORMED OR AN
- 30 AUXILIARY LOCATION UTILIZED BY A HOSPITAL, HEALTH CARE

- 1 SYSTEM OR PHARMACY TO PROVIDE COVID-19 VACCINATIONS WITH
- 2 COVID-19 VACCINES OBTAINED BY THE RESPECTIVE HOSPITAL,
- 3 HEALTH CARE SYSTEM OR PHARMACY.
- 4 (II) A LOCATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) PRIMARILY OR
- 5 EXCLUSIVELY PROVIDING COVID-19 VACCINATIONS TO
- 6 INDIVIDUALS AT THEIR OWN PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT, OR TO
- 7 INDIVIDUALS IN A SPECIFIC FIELD OF EMPLOYMENT, INCLUDING
- 8 TEACHERS, AGRICULTURAL WORKERS, GROCERY STORE EMPLOYEES
- 9 OR OTHER INDIVIDUALS DEEMED AS ESSENTIAL WORKERS.
- 10 (III) A LOCATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) PRIMARILY OR
- 11 EXCLUSIVELY PROVIDING COVID-19 VACCINATIONS TO
- 12 INDIVIDUALS COVERED UNDER A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING
- 13 AGREEMENT.
- 14 SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATION.
- 15 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER ACT TO THE CONTRARY, AN INDIVIDUAL
- 16 AUTHORIZED TO ADMINISTER A COVID-19 VACCINE BY THE UNITED STATES
- 17 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES UNDER THE SEVENTH
- 18 AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION UNDER THE PUBLIC READINESS AND
- 19 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS ACT FOR MEDICAL COUNTERMEASURES AGAINST
- 20 COVID-19 SHALL BE PERMITTED TO ADMINISTER VACCINES IN THIS
- 21 COMMONWEALTH, INCLUDING:
- 22 (1) A MIDWIFE, PARAMEDIC, ADVANCED OR INTERMEDIATE
- 23 EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT,
- 24 RESPIRATORY THERAPIST, DENTIST, PODIATRIST, OPTOMETRIST OR
- 25 VETERINARIAN LICENSED, REGISTERED OR CERTIFIED TO PRACTICE
- 26 UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH.
- 27 (2) A PHYSICIAN, ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSE,
- 28 REGISTERED NURSE, PRACTICAL NURSE, PHARMACIST, PHARMACY
- 29 INTERN, MIDWIFE, PARAMEDIC, ADVANCED OR INTERMEDIATE
- 30 EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, RESPIRATORY THERAPIST, DENTIST,

- 1 PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT, PODIATRIST, OPTOMETRIST OR VETERINARIAN
- 2 WHO HAS HELD AN ACTIVE LICENSE, REGISTRATION OR CERTIFICATION
- 3 UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH WITHIN THE LAST FIVE
- 4 YEARS, WHICH IS INACTIVE, EXPIRED OR LAPSED, IF THE LICENSE,
- 5 REGISTRATION OR CERTIFICATION WAS ACTIVE AND IN GOOD STANDING
- 6 PRIOR TO THE DATE IT WENT INACTIVE, EXPIRED OR LAPSED AND WAS
- 7 NOT REVOKED BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY, SURRENDERED WHILE
- 8 UNDER SUSPENSION, DISCIPLINE OR INVESTIGATION BY A LICENSING
- 9 AUTHORITY OR SURRENDERED FOLLOWING AN ARREST, AND THE
- 10 INDIVIDUAL IS NOT ON THE LIST OF EXCLUDED
- 11 INDIVIDUALS/ENTITIES MAINTAINED BY THE OFFICE OF INSPECTOR
- 12 GENERAL.
- 13 (3) A MEDICAL, NURSING, PHARMACY, PHARMACY INTERN,
- 14 MIDWIFE, PARAMEDIC, ADVANCED OR INTERMEDIATE EMERGENCY
- 15 MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT, RESPIRATORY THERAPY,
- 16 DENTAL, PODIATRY, OPTOMETRY OR VETERINARY STUDENT WITH
- 17 APPROPRIATE TRAINING IN ADMINISTERING VACCINES AS DETERMINED
- 18 BY HIS OR HER SCHOOL OR TRAINING PROGRAM, AND UNDER THE
- 19 DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A CURRENTLY PRACTICING HEALTH CARE
- 20 PROFESSIONAL WHO IS LICENSED, REGISTERED OR CERTIFIED IN THIS
- 21 COMMONWEALTH AND WHO IS EXPERIENCED IN ADMINISTERING
- 22 INTRAMUSCULAR INJECTIONS.
- 23 SECTION 4. REQUIREMENTS.
- 24 INDIVIDUALS WHO GAIN AUTHORIZATION TO ADMINISTER COVID-19
- 25 VACCINES UNDER THIS ACT ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING
- 26 REQUIREMENTS:
- 27 (1) INDIVIDUALS MUST HAVE DOCUMENTATION SHOWING:
- 28 (I) CURRENT BASIC LIFE SUPPORT CERTIFICATION,
- 29 COMMONLY KNOWN AS BASIC CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION OR
- 30 CPR.

- 1 (II) COMPLETION OF AN IMMUNIZATION TRAINING PROGRAM
- 2 ENDORSED OR PROVIDED BY THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL
- 3 AND PREVENTION, THE ACCREDITATION COUNCIL FOR PHARMACY
- 4 EDUCATION OR ANY SIMILAR TRAINING APPROVED BY THE
- 5 SECRETARY OF HEALTH THAT, AT A MINIMUM, INCLUDES:
- 6 (A) HANDS-ON INJECTION TECHNIQUE.
- 7 (B) CLINICAL EVALUATION OF INDICATIONS AND
- 8 CONTRAINDICATIONS OF VACCINES.
- 9 (C) RECOGNITION AND TREATMENT OF EMERGENCY
- 10 REACTIONS TO VACCINES.
- 11 (2) (RESERVED).
- 12 SECTION 5. OBSERVATION PERIOD.
- 13 HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS AND STUDENTS WHO GAIN AUTHORIZATION
- 14 TO ADMINISTER COVID-19 VACCINES UNDER THIS ACT MUST HAVE
- 15 DOCUMENTATION OF AN OBSERVATION PERIOD BY A CURRENTLY PRACTICING
- 16 HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCED IN ADMINISTERING
- 17 INTRAMUSCULAR INJECTIONS, AND FOR WHOM ADMINISTERING
- 18 INTRAMUSCULAR INJECTIONS IS IN THEIR ORDINARY SCOPE OF PRACTICE,
- 19 WHO CONFIRMS COMPETENCY OF THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER OR STUDENT
- 20 IN ADMINISTRATION OF COVID-19 VACCINES.
- 21 SECTION 6. RECORDKEEPING.
- 22 HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS AND STUDENTS WHO GAIN AUTHORIZATION
- 23 TO ADMINISTER COVID-19 VACCINES UNDER THIS ACT MUST COMPLY WITH
- 24 RECORDKEEPING AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS AS DETERMINED BY THE
- 25 SECRETARY OF HEALTH.
- 26 SECTION 7. VACCINE DATA.
- 27 NO LATER THAN 14 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 28 SECTION AND NOT LESS THAN EACH 14 DAYS THEREAFTER, THE
- 29 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SHALL PUBLISH ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ON THE
- 30 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH'S PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE:

- 1 (1) A CHART SHOWING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF DOSES OF VACCINE
- 2 FOR COVID-19 MADE AVAILABLE IN EACH COUNTY. THE DATA UNDER
- 3 THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL INCLUDE VACCINES MADE AVAILABLE FROM ALL
- 4 SOURCES, INCLUDING FEDERAL PARTNERSHIPS.
- 5 (2) A CHART SHOWING THE DATA UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)
- 6 SEPARATED BY VACCINE MANUFACTURER.
- 7 (3) A CHART SHOWING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF DOSES OF VACCINE
- 8 FOR COVID-19 ADMINISTERED IN EACH COUNTY. THE DATA UNDER THIS
- 9 PARAGRAPH SHALL INCLUDE VACCINES MADE AVAILABLE FROM ALL
- 10 SOURCES, INCLUDING FEDERAL PARTNERSHIPS.
- 11 (4) A CHART SHOWING THE DATA UNDER PARAGRAPH (3)
- 12 SEPARATED BY VACCINE MANUFACTURER.
- 13 (5) TO THE EXTENT THE DATA IS AVAILABLE, DEMOGRAPHIC
- 14 DATA, INCLUDING AGE AND RACE, OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE BEEN
- 15 ADMINISTERED A COVID-19 VACCINE.
- 16 (6) A DESCRIPTION OF THE FORMULA OR ALLOCATION CRITERIA
- 17 THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH HAS USED TO ALLOCATE DOSES OF
- 18 VACCINE FOR COVID-19 TO EACH COUNTY. THE DESCRIPTION UNDER
- 19 THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL INCLUDE A SUMMARY OF EACH FACTOR IN THE
- 20 FORMULA OR ALLOCATION CRITERIA AND, IF APPLICABLE, THE
- 21 RELATIVE WEIGHT GIVEN TO EACH FACTOR.
- 22 (7) A DESCRIPTION OF HOW THE FORMULA OR ALLOCATION
- 23 CRITERIA UNDER PARAGRAPH (6) WAS DEVELOPED.
- 24 (8) AN ESTIMATE OF THE TOTAL POPULATION IN EACH COUNTY
- 25 WHICH ARE ELIGIBLE UNDER EACH CATEGORY OF ELIGIBILITY FOR
- 26 DOSES OF VACCINE FOR COVID-19 ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT
- OF HEALTH.
- 28 (9) AN ESTIMATE OF THE POPULATION IN EACH COUNTY UNDER
- 29 PARAGRAPH (8) WHICH HAVE NOT RECEIVED A DOSE OF VACCINE FOR
- 30 COVID-19 AT THE TIME OF THE PUBLISHING OF THE CHART.

- 1 SECTION 8. VACCINE DISTRIBUTION PLAN.
- 2 NO LATER THAN 14 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 3 SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE
- 4 PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE, THE MAJORITY LEADER OF THE
- 5 SENATE, THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE
- 6 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE MAJORITY LEADER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 7 REPRESENTATIVES, THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 8 REPRESENTATIVES, THE CHAIRPERSON AND MINORITY CHAIRPERSON OF THE
- 9 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE AND THE
- 10 CHAIRPERSON AND MINORITY CHAIRPERSON OF THE HEALTH COMMITTEE OF
- 11 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES. THE REPORT SHALL DESCRIBE THE
- 12 MEANS BY WHICH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH WILL PROVIDE SUFFICIENT
- 13 DOSES OF COVID-19 VACCINE TO COUNTIES THAT HAVE REQUESTED MORE
- 14 DOSES OF COVID-19 VACCINE THAN THE COUNTY RECEIVED FROM THE
- 15 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.
- 16 SECTION 9. DISTRIBUTION OF COVID-19 VACCINES TO A MASS
- 17 VACCINATION SITE.
- 18 THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SHALL DELIVER COVID-19 VACCINES
- 19 INTENDED FOR USE AT A MASS VACCINATION SITE IN AN AFFECTED
- 20 COUNTY TO THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT OF THE AFFECTED COUNTY, OR THE
- 21 COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT OVERSEEING THE RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19
- 22 PANDEMIC FOR THE AFFECTED COUNTY. THE GOVERNING BOARD OF EACH
- 23 AFFECTED COUNTY SHALL HAVE SOLE AUTHORITY TO DESIGNATE A
- 24 LOCATION OR LOCATIONS TO BE UTILIZED AS A MASS VACCINATION SITE
- 25 OR SITES WITHIN THE COUNTY AND SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE
- 26 APPROPRIATE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR THE DELIVERY AND
- 27 ADMINISTRATION OF COVID-19 VACCINES AT EACH MASS VACCINATION
- 28 SITE.
- 29 SECTION 10. EXPIRATION.
- 30 THIS ACT SHALL EXPIRE 60 DAYS AFTER THE TERMINATION OF THE

- 1 GOVERNOR'S COVID-19 EMERGENCY DECLARATION ORDER, OR DECEMBER 31,
- 2 2022, WHICHEVER IS EARLIER.
- 3 SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 4 THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
