## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in other offenses, prohibiting the use
- of sky lanterns.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 7518. Prohibited use of sky lanterns.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits an offense if the
- 10 person releases a sky lantern into the air space above the
- 11 <u>surface of the ground within this Commonwealth, unless the sky</u>
- 12 lantern is tethered or otherwise restricted from floating
- 13 <u>freely.</u>
- 14 (b) Grading.--A violation of this section is a misdemeanor
- 15 of the third degree.
- (c) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 17 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 18 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1 "Sky lantern." An unmanned and self-contained luminary
- 2 <u>device that uses heated air produced by an open flame or another</u>
- 3 <u>source to become or remain airborne.</u>
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
