## AN ACT

Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 1951, carrying 1 State Route 4017 on Wetzel Road, Shaler Township, Allegheny 2 County, as the Commander William J. Schofield, III, Memorial 3 Bridge. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Commander William J. Schofield, III, Memorial 7 8 Bridge. 9 Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as 10 follows: 11 Commander William J. Schofield, III, was born on August 12, 1926. 12 13 Commander Schofield graduated from Central Catholic 14 High School in 1944 and enlisted in the United States Navy 15 during World War II. 16 Upon his discharge from the military in 1946,

Commander Schofield attended the University of Pittsburgh

while continuing to serve in the Naval Reserve.

- 1 (4) In 1949, Commander Schofield received his
- 2 undergraduate degree from the University of Pittsburgh and a

- 4 (5) Commander Schofield served as a surface warfare ship
- 5 pilot and retired as group commander for reserve activities

- 7 (6) Commander Schofield was a member of the executive

- 12 Allegheny County, a board member of the Kiwanis Club of
- 13 Glenshaw, a former president of the Shaler Area school board
- 14 from 1976 to 1981 and 1986 to 1993, a board secretary of the
- 15 Institute for Research, Education and Training in Addictions
- and a member of the Allegheny County Local Emergency Planning
- 17 Committee and the Pennsylvania State Association of County
- 18 Directors of Veterans Affairs.
- 19 (7) Commander William J. Schofield, III, died on January
- 20 24, 2005, of natural causes.
- 21 (b) Designation. -- The bridge, identified as Bridge Key 1951,
- 22 carrying State Route 4017 on Wetzel Road, Shaler Township,
- 23 Allegheny County, is designated the Commander William J.
- 24 Schofield, III, Memorial Bridge.
- 25 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 26 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 27 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 28 Section 2. Effective date.
- 29 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
