## AN ACT

- 1 Restricting local government from certain regulation of
  2 agritourism.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Restriction
- 7 on Local Regulation of Agritourism Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Agricultural land." Land which is used for a normal
- 13 agricultural operation.
- "Agritourism activity."
- 15 (1) A farm-related tourism or farm-related entertainment
- 16 activity that takes place on agricultural land and allows
- 17 members of the general public, whether or not for a fee, to
- tour, explore, observe, learn about, participate in or be

- 1 entertained by an aspect of agricultural production,
- 2 harvesting, husbandry or rural lifestyle that occurs on the
- 3 farm.
- 4 (2) The term shall not include overnight accommodations,
- 5 weddings, concerts or provisions for food and beverage
- 6 services.
- 7 "Limited license." A limited winery license or limited
- 8 distillery license issued under the act of April 12, 1951
- 9 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code.
- "Limited seasonal event." An event that occurs on
- 11 agricultural land to coincide with the celebration of a season
- 12 of the year or holiday and that highlights a seasonal or holiday
- 13 appropriate farm activity or phenomenon of wildlife or nature.
- "Local government." A municipality, zoning hearing board or
- 15 other board of a municipality.
- 16 "Municipality." A county, city, borough, incorporated town
- 17 or township.
- 18 "Normal agricultural operation." As defined in the act of
- 19 June 10, 1982 (P.L.454, No.133), referred to as the Right-to-
- 20 Farm Law.
- "Retail food facility." As defined in 3 Pa.C.S. § 5702
- 22 (relating to definitions).
- 23 Section 3. Restriction on local regulation.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a
- 25 local government may not prohibit the use of agricultural land
- 26 for:
- 27 (1) agricultural purposes or for the construction of
- buildings or structures incident to the use of the land for
- 29 agricultural purposes;
- 30 (2) an agritourism activity;

- 1 (3) a limited seasonal event;
- 2 (4) an activity that requires a limited license;
- 3 (5) a retail food facility;
- 4 (6) a wedding; or
- 5 (7) musical entertainment that accompanies an activity
- 6 under paragraphs (1), (2), (3), (4), (5) or (6) and which is
- 7 in compliance with applicable noise and nuisance ordinances.
- 8 Section 4. Exception.
- 9 The restriction on local government action under section 3
- 10 shall not extend to the following:
- 11 (1) The size of a structure used primarily for an
- 12 activity under section 3.
- 13 (2) The size of a parking area required for an activity
- 14 under section 3. This paragraph does not include requirements
- relating to drainage, parking area base, parking area paving
- or any other improvement.
- 17 (3) A property line setback for a structure used
- primarily for an activity under section 3.
- 19 (4) Where necessary to protect public health and safety,
- 20 egress and ingress on land used for an activity under section
- 21 3.
- 22 Section 5. Effective date.
- 23 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
