## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 20, 1985 (P.L.457, No.112), 1 entitled "An act relating to the right to practice medicine 2 and surgery and the right to practice medically related acts; 3 reestablishing the State Board of Medical Education and Licensure as the State Board of Medicine and providing for 5 its composition, powers and duties; providing for the issuance of licenses and certificates and the suspension and 7 revocation of licenses and certificates; provided penalties; and making repeals," further providing for license without restriction. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 29(c) of the act of December 20, 1985 14 (P.L.457, No.112), known as the Medical Practice Act of 1985, is 15 amended to read: 16 Section 29. License without restriction. \* \* \* 17 18 (c) Graduates of unaccredited medical colleges. -- No license 19 without restriction may be issued to a graduate of an 20 unaccredited medical college unless the applicant has completed successfully, as a resident, [three] two years of approved 21
