- 11 (a) General rule. -- Any person licensed or certified by the
- 12 Department of State, Department of Labor and Industry,
- 13 Department of Education, Insurance Department, Department of
- 14 Banking or the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training
- 15 Commission or pursuant to the act of October 10, 1974 (P.L.705,
- 16 No.235), known as the Lethal Weapons Training Act, to practice
- 17 any profession or to work at any trade or occupation, who
- 18 heretofore has or shall thereafter enlist or be inducted or
- 19 drafted into the military or naval service of the United States

- 27 the date of discharge and payment of the fee prescribed by law
- 28 for the current renewal period only, be entitled to a renewal of
- 29 his or her license, certification or registration in the same
- 30 manner as though:

- 1 (1) The renewal had been made prior to the expiration of
- 2 his or her last preceding renewal.
- 3 (2) All intermediate renewal fees had been paid.
- 4 (3) All continuing education or in-service training
- 5 requirements have been satisfied.
- 6 (c) Exemptions. -- A veteran's military service, education,
- 7 training and service experience shall be taken into
- 8 consideration by the entities listed under subsection (a) to
- 9 determine whether a licensing or certification requirement has
- 10 been met by or can otherwise be waived by reason of that
- 11 military service, education, training or experience. The veteran
- 12 shall only be required to meet a licensing or certification
- 13 requirement which has not been met by or waived under this
- 14 subsection.

- 30 (a) Adoption. -- The Department of Education shall adopt a

- 1 policy for the award of academic credit to a student enrolled in
- 2 <u>an educational institution who has successfully completed a</u>
- 3 military training course or program as part of the student's
- 4 military service that is applicable to the student's certificate
- 5 of degree requirements and is:
- 6 (1) recommended for academic credit by a national higher
- 7 <u>education association that provides academic credit</u>
- 8 <u>recommendations for military training courses or programs;</u>
- 9 (2) noted on the student's military transcript issued by
- 10 any of the armed forces of the United States, including a
- 11 <u>reserve component or National Guard; or</u>
- 12 (3) otherwise documented in writing by any of the armed
- forces of the United States, including a reserve component or
- 14 <u>National Guard.</u>
- 15 <u>(b) Duties.--The Department of Education shall:</u>
- (1) develop a procedure for each educational institution
- 17 to receive the documentation necessary to identify and verify
- the military training course or program for which the student
- 19 has applied for academic credit; and
- 20 (2) develop, maintain and disseminate to each
- 21 educational institution a list of military training courses
- and programs that the Department of Education has deemed
- 23 qualified for the award of academic credit.
- 24 (c) Provision of copy. -- Each educational institution shall
- 25 provide a copy of the Department of Education's policy for the
- 26 award of academic credit for military training courses or
- 27 programs to each student applicant.
- 28 Section 8. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
