AS REPORTED FROM COMMITTEE ON LIQUOR CONTROL, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AS AMENDED, MARCH 16, 2021

AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled "An
2 act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and
3 brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and
4 changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and
5 restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession,
6 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding
7 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic
8 liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the
9 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and
10 duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing
11 for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores,
12 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective
13 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain
14 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure
15 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures;
16 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," in
17 licenses and regulations and liquor, alcohol and malt and
18 brewed beverages, further providing for sales by liquor
19 licensees and restrictions.

20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
21 hereby enacts as follows:

22 Section 1. Section 406 of the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90,
23 No.21), known as the Liquor Code, is amended by adding a
24 subsection to read:

25 Section 406. Sales by Liquor Licensees; Restrictions.--* * *

1 ~~(j) Liquor, wine and malt or brewed beverages~~ AND WINE in <--
2 the possession of a licensee at the time the licensed business
3 closes permanently may be sold to another licensee qualified to
4 sell such products. The licensee shall notify the board in
5 writing advising the board of the name of the licensee and
6 identifying any product sold to that licensee, as well as the
7 description of the liquor, including brand names, sizes and
8 numbers of containers sold to another licensee.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
