## AN ACT

Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in veterans' pensions and benefits, 2 further providing for blind veteran's pension and for amputee 3 and paralyzed veteran's pension. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 7 Section 1. Sections 7701(b) and 7702(a) of Title 51 of the 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 9 § 7701. Blind veteran's pension. \* \* \* 10 11 Amount and eligibility.--In addition to any other (b) 12 assistance provided by the Commonwealth and in addition to any 13 compensation provided by the Federal Government, every blind veteran shall be paid a pension of [\$150] \$200 per month. 14 15 Applications for such pensions shall be made to and in the form prescribed by the department. The Adjutant General shall have 16

1 the power, and it shall be his duty to determine the eligibility 2 of every applicant for a pension, and his decision in the matter 3 shall be final.

4 § 7702. Amputee and paralyzed veteran's pension.

5 (a) Amount and eligibility.--In addition to any other assistance provided by the Commonwealth and in addition to any 6 7 compensation provided by the Federal Government, every amputee 8 and paralyzed veteran shall be paid a pension of [\$150] \$200 per month. Applications for the pensions shall be made to and in the 9 10 form prescribed by the department. The Adjutant General shall determine the eligibility of every applicant for a pension, and 11 his decision in the matter shall be final. 12
