AN ACT

Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in rates and distribution systems, 2 further providing for rates to be just and reasonable. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 1301 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 8 § 1301. Rates to be just and reasonable. * * * 9 10 (c) COVID-19 limitation.--11 (1) Notwithstanding any other law, rule, regulation or order of the commission, a public utility may not increase a 12 13 rate to recover lost revenue if the lost revenue is 14 attributable to COVID-19 or COVID-19-related mitigation 15 measures, including those within the scope of the order 16 issued by the Governor on March 19, 2020, to limit the 17 operation of non-life-sustaining businesses.

(2) For purposes of this subsection, the term "COVID-19"

- 1 means the coronavirus disease 2019, an infectious disease
- 2 <u>caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2</u>
- 3 that was first identified during December 2019 in Wuhan,
- 4 China.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
