AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 2 Statutes, in powers of department and local authorities, further providing for specific powers of department and local 3 authorities. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 6109(a)(3) of Title 75 of the 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is 9 amended by adding a subsection SUBSECTIONS to read: <--10 § 6109. Specific powers of department and local authorities. 11 Enumeration of police powers. -- The provisions of this 12 title shall not be deemed to prevent the department on State-13 designated highways and local authorities on streets or highways 14 within their physical boundaries from the reasonable exercise of 15 their police powers. The following are presumed to be reasonable 16 exercises of police power: * * * 17

[Regulating] Subject to subsection (i) SUBSECTIONS <--

- 1 (J) AND (J.1), regulating or prohibiting processions, special
- 2 <u>activities</u> or assemblages on highways.
- 3 * * *
- 4 (j) Permits for processions, special activities and
- 5 <u>assemblages on State-designated highways.--The department may</u>
- 6 <u>not require, as a condition for the approval of a permit for a</u>
- 7 procession, special activity or assemblage on a State-designated
- 8 <u>highway</u>, a local authority to submit a statement that the local_
- 9 <u>authority will agree to fully indemnify</u>, save harmless and
- 10 defend the Commonwealth, Commonwealth departments and their
- 11 officers, agents and employees from and against claims, suits or
- 12 actions for injury, death or property damage arising from or
- 13 because of the acts or omissions of its officers, agents or
- 14 employees or of the sponsor of the procession, special activity
- 15 <u>or assemblage, unless IF all of the following conditions are</u>
- 16 met:
- 17 <u>(1) The sponsor of the procession, special activity or</u>
- 18 <u>assemblage is not the local authority.</u>
- 19 (2) The sponsor will fully indemnify, save harmless and,
- if requested, defend the Commonwealth, Commonwealth
- 21 <u>departments</u>, and their officers, agents and employees from
- 22 and against claims, suits or actions for injury, death or
- 23 property damage arising from or because of the acts or
- omissions of the sponsor, its officers, agents or employees.
- 25 (3) The sponsor names the department as an additional
- insured on its liability policies and the liability insurance
- 27 policies are occurrence based and the insurance certificate
- indicates that the insurance is occurrence based.
- 29 (4) The sponsor agrees to reimburse the Commonwealth for
- 30 all costs for police escort and traffic-control services.

1	(5) The local authority approves of the sponsor
2	conducting the procession, special activity or assemblage.
3	(6) The local authority agrees to provide adequate
4	detour signing or police controls for the rerouting of
5	traffic along an alternate route, if requested by the
6	department.
7	(J.1) SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY
8	(1) NOTHING IN SUBSECTION (J) SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO
9	REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT TO ISSUE A PERMIT FOR A PROCESSION,
10	ASSEMBLAGE OR SPECIAL ACTIVITY THAT WILL OCCUR ON A STREET,
11	HIGHWAY OR REAL ESTATE DEEMED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO BE UNSAFE
12	FOR USE BY PARTICIPANTS. THE DEPARTMENT, ITS SERVANTS AND
13	AGENTS, EMPLOYEES AND REPRESENTATIVES ACTING ON ITS BEHALF
14	SHALL BE IMMUNE FROM SUIT BY PARTICIPANTS FOR PERSONAL
15	INJURIES OR PROPERTY DAMAGES ARISING DURING A PROCESSION,
16	ASSEMBLAGE OR SPECIAL ACTIVITY PERMITTED BY THE DEPARTMENT
17	UNDER 42 PA.C.S. §§ 8521 (RELATING TO SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY
18	GENERALLY) AND 8522 (RELATING TO EXCEPTIONS TO SOVEREIGN
19	<pre>IMMUNITY).</pre>
20	(2) THE TERM "PARTICIPANTS" SHALL INCLUDE SPECTATORS,
21	EVENT SPONSORS, MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS, POLICE, FIRE POLICE,
22	MEDIA AND OTHERS PRESENT DURING THE PROCESSION, ASSEMBLAGE OR
23	SPECIAL ACTIVITY PERMITTED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
24	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
