- 7 (2) THE UPDATED NOTICE MAY BE PROVIDED ELECTRONICALLY TO
- 8 A SHERIFF'S OFFICE IF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY
- 9 <u>CAN CONFIRM RECEIPT OF THE UPDATED NOTICE.</u>
