AN ACT

Amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), entitled "An act establishing rights in public employes to organize and bargain collectively through selected representatives; defining public employes to include employes of nonprofit organizations and institutions; providing compulsory mediation and fact-finding, for collective bargaining impasses; providing arbitration for certain public employes for collective bargaining impasses; defining the scope of collective bargaining; establishing unfair employe and employer practices; prohibiting strikes for certain public employes; permitting strikes under limited conditions; providing penalties for violations; and establishing procedures for implementation," in scope of bargaining, further providing for proper subjects of collective bargaining.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 705 of the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, is amended to read:

Section 705. (a) Membership dues deductions and maintenance of membership are proper subjects of bargaining with the proviso that as to the latter, the payment of dues and assessments while members, may be the only requisite employment condition.

1 (b) Public employe Social Security numbers, home addresses, home telephone numbers, personal mobile telephone numbers and personal e-mail addresses are not proper subjects of collective

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
