## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, providing
- for extended special education enrollment due to COVID-19 and
- for optional year of education due to COVID-19.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding sections
- 12 to read:
- 13 Section 1383. Extended Special Education Enrollment Due to
- 14 COVID-19.--(a) For the 2021-2022 school year, a parent or
- 15 guardian may enroll a student with a disability as defined in 22
- 16 Pa. Code § 14.101 (relating to definitions) who, during the
- 17 <u>2020-2021 school year, was enrolled in a school entity and</u>
- 18 reached 21 years of age on or after the issuance of the

- 1 proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on
- 2 March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020).
- 3 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
- 4 <u>following apply to a student enrolled in a school entity under</u>
- 5 <u>subsection</u> (a):
- 6 (1) The school entity shall enroll the student in accordance
- 7 with the student's IEP.
- 8 (2) The student may enroll in the school entity for the
- 9 2021-2022 school year free of charge until the end of the school
- 10 year.
- 11 (3) The student's attendance shall be included in the school
- 12 <u>entity's average daily membership for purposes of calculating</u>
- 13 the special education subsidy under Article XXV.
- 14 (c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 15 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 16 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 17 "IEP." An individualized education program established under
- 18 22 Pa. Code Ch. 14 (relating to special education services and
- 19 programs).
- 20 "School entity." A school district, intermediate unit, area
- 21 career and technical school, charter school, cyber charter
- 22 <u>school, regional charter school or nonpublic school entity.</u>
- 23 Section 1384. Optional Year of Education Due to COVID-19.--
- 24 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for the 2021-
- 25 2022 school year, a parent or quardian may elect to have a
- 26 student with a disability as defined in 22 Pa. Code § 14.101
- 27 <u>(relating to definitions) in a school entity repeat a grade</u>
- 28 <u>level to make up for any lost educational opportunities during</u>
- 29 the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school years regardless of whether
- 30 the child met the requirements to be promoted to the next grade

- 1 level. The parental election under this subsection includes
- 2 <u>participation in all academic or extr</u>acurricular activities,
- 3 except for interscholastic athletics.
- 4 (b) A school entity shall create a process for a parent or
- 5 guardian to make the election under subsection (a) and post the
- 6 process on the publicly accessible Internet website of the
- 7 school entity.
- 8 (c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 9 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 10 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 11 "Interscholastic athletics." All athletic contests or
- 12 competitions conducted between or among school entities situated
- 13 <u>in a school district.</u>
- 14 <u>"School entity." A school district, intermediate unit, area</u>
- 15 <u>career and technical school, charter school, cyber charter</u>
- 16 school, regional charter school or nonpublic school entity.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
