## AN ACT

Amending the act of January 17, 1968 (P.L.11, No.5), entitled "An act establishing a fixed minimum wage and overtime rates for employes, with certain exceptions; providing for minimum rates for learners and apprentices; creating a Minimum Wage Advisory Board and defining its powers and duties; conferring powers and imposing duties upon the Department of Labor and Industry; imposing duties on employers; and providing penalties," further providing for minimum wages; and repealing provisions relating to preemption.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 4 of the act of January 17, 1968 (P.L.11, No.5), known as The Minimum Wage Act of 1968 , is amended by adding a subsection to read:

Section 4. Minimum Wages.--Except as may otherwise be provided under this act:

(a.2) A municipality may adopt an ordinance that provides for a greater wage rate than that required under subsection (a) and the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 (52 Stat. 1060, 29
