AN ACT

Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public 2 welfare laws of the Commonwealth," providing for departmental 3 powers and duties as to small personal care homes. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding an article to 8 9 read: 10 ARTICLE IX-A 11 DEPARTMENTAL POWERS AND DUTIES AS TO 12 SMALL PERSONAL CARE HOMES Section 901-A. Definitions. 13 14 The following words and phrases when used in this article 15 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 16 context clearly indicates otherwise: 17 "Relative." A parent, child, stepparent, stepchild, grandparent, grandchild, brother, sister, half brother, half 18 sister, aunt, uncle, niece or nephew. 19

_	Small personal care nome. As lollows.
2	(1) A premises where food, shelter and personal
3	assistance or supervision are provided in exchange for
4	compensation for a period exceeding 24 hours for three or
5	fewer adults who meet the following criteria:
6	(i) They are not relatives of the operator.
7	(ii) They do not require the services of a licensed
8	<pre>long-term care facility.</pre>
9	(iii) They do require assistance or supervision in
10	such matters as dressing, bathing, diet, financial
11	management, evacuation of a residence in the event of an
12	emergency or medication prescribed for self
13	administration.
14	(2) The term does not include a personal care home as
15	defined in section 1001.
16	"Small personal care home administrator." An individual who
17	is charged with the general administration of a small personal
18	care home, whether or not the individual has an ownership
19	interest in the home or the individual's functions and duties
20	are shared with other individuals.
21	Section 902-A. Right of department to enter and inspect.
22	For the purpose of determining the suitability of a small
23	personal care home or whether the small personal care home is in
24	compliance with the regulations promulgated under section 907-A,
25	the following shall apply:
26	(1) In addition to the required annual inspection under
27	section 905-A, an authorized agent of the department may
28	enter, visit and inspect the small personal care home.
29	(2) An authorized agent of the department shall have
30	full and free access to the records of the small personal

- 2 care home, including the full opportunity to interview,
- 3 inspect or examine the individuals.
- 4 (3) An authorized agent of the department may confer
- 5 with the small personal care home administrator regarding the
- 6 <u>minimum standards of the department, encourage the adoption</u>
- 7 <u>of higher standards and recommend methods of improving care</u>
- 8 and services.
- 9 <u>Section 903-A. Duties of small personal care home</u>
- 10 administrators.
- 11 A small personal care home administrator shall have the
- 12 <u>following duties:</u>
- 13 (1) Maintaining, operating and conducting a small
- 14 <u>personal care home in accordance with the regulations</u>
- promulgated under section 907-A.
- 16 (2) Keeping records and making reports as may be
- 17 required by the department.
- 18 Section 904-A. Criminal history record information.
- 19 No person shall provide assistance or supervision in a small
- 20 personal care home unless the person submits criminal history
- 21 record information from the Pennsylvania State Police to the
- 22 <u>department</u>.
- 23 Section 905-A. Required annual inspection.
- The department shall annually conduct at least one
- 25 unannounced onsite inspection of each small personal care home.
- 26 Section 906-A. Registry.
- 27 <u>The department shall establish a small personal care home</u>
- 28 registry. An individual who seeks to become a small personal
- 29 care home administrator or is designated as a small personal
- 30 care home administrator by the department shall register with

- 1 the department on a form prescribed by the department.
- 2 Section 907-A. Regulations.
- 3 The department shall promulgate regulations establishing
- 4 minimum standards for building, equipment, operation, care,
- 5 programs and services, training and staffing of small personal
- 6 <u>care homes.</u>
- 7 Section 908-A. Penalties.
- 8 If a person violates the provisions of this article or
- 9 regulations promulgated under section 907-A, the department,
- 10 upon the advice of the Attorney General, may maintain an action
- 11 <u>in the name of the Commonwealth for an injunction or other</u>
- 12 process restraining or prohibiting the person from engaging in
- 13 <u>such activity.</u>
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
