13	Section 2. Records of discharges, reports of separation and
14	similar forms recorded or received by the recorder of deeds for
15	recording under section 1 shall be confidential and no
16	disclosure thereof shall be made by the recorder of deeds except
17	as follows:

1 (2) To a person making a request for a record, report or 2 form when the event that resulted in the record, report or form 3 occurred more than [seventy-five] eighty-five years prior to the 4 request.

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
